## The **Ebonite** Midwest Open Rules & Regs

General Info: The Ebonite Midwest Open, a USBC-certified scratch singles bowling tournament (#11441), will be conducted on Saturday & Sunday, July 29-30, 2017 at Beaver-Vu Bowl, 1238 N. Fairfield Rd., Beavercreek, OH 45432. 937.426.6771. daytonbowling.com

Anyone can bowl (adult/youth, male/female, amateur/professional). Bowlers may enter more than one Qualifying Round squad, if desired, but may only use their highest Qualifying Round score for advancement to the Championship Round.

Entry Fee: The tournament entry fee is \$95.00 with an optional re-entry fee \$90.00. Breakdown of \$95.00 entry fee: lineage/expenses: \$25.00. Prize fund: \$70.00. Breakdown of \$90.00 re-entry fee: lineage/expenses: \$20.00. Prize fund: \$70.00. Only paid entries will be accepted

Format: Qualifying Round - All participants bowl 5 games across 10 lanes. The lanes will be re-oiled for each Qualifying Round squad. The lane pattern will be posted in the tournament office. 1 lane courtesy rule.

The following are <u>guaranteed</u> to advance to the Sunday Championship Round:

- The high qualifier in each Qualifying Round.
- The high overall adult female qualifier.
- The high overall senior (age 50+ as of 8.1.16) qualifier.
- The high overall youth qualifier (age 20 & under as of 8.1.16. Boy or girl).

Field Advancement to the Championship Round - 96 or fewer total Qualifying Round entries: 16. 97+ total Qualifying Round entries: 24. Ties for the final advancing place to the Championship Round and ties for 1st round bracket placement will be broken by the high game(s) rolled in the Qualifying Round.

Championship Round - Sunday, July 30th with practice starting a 9:00 AM. All scores from the Qualifying Round will be dropped. The Championship Round will be a best 2 of 3 game single elimination match play bracket. If the Championship Round field is 24 bowlers, the top 8 bowlers from the Qualifying Round will receive a 1st round bye. Ties in any Championship Round game will be broken by a 9th/10th frame roll-off. In each match (or tiebreaker roll-off) the higher seed will determine their starting lane.

Final Standings - The final standings in the Championship Round (with a field of 24 bowlers) will be determined as follows: 1st place: winner of the final Championship Round match.

2nd place: loser of the final Championship Round match.

**3rd place and 4th place**: the highest seeded loser in Championship Round match four will place 3rd. The lowest seeded loser in Championship Round match four will place 4th.

5th place through 8th place: the four losers in Championship Round match three will be awarded 5th-8th place ranked from

9th place through 16th place: the eight losers in Championship Round match two will be awarded 9th-16th place ranked from highest seeded bowler to lowest.

17th place through 24th place: the eight losers in Championship Round match one will be awarded 17th-24th place ranked from highest seeded bowler to lowest

25th place through remainder of Qualifying Round Field: standings will be determined based on the highest to lowest Qualifying Round scores.

If the Championship Round field is 16 bowlers (based on 96 or fewer total Qualifying Round entries), the same method for determining the final tournament standings (top 16) will apply.

#### Awards:

- 1:5 participants will cash based on final tournament standings.
- The top bowler in each Qualifying Round will receive \$100.00.
- Awards won by any youth bowler will be deposited with The SMART Program (Account# 08871).
- Optional high game jackpots & brackets will be available in each Qualifying Round squad.
