- 7. ACTION ITEM City Council to consider adoption of Ordinance 407, the annual Appropriation Ordinance. The appropriations budget workshops were held, as per Idaho Code, July 16, 2025- August 21, 2025. A public hearing notice for the fiscal year 2025-2026 budget was published in the Moscow-Pullman Daily News on Aug 28th & September 4th, 2025. Appropriating the sum of \$1,448,233.00 to defray the expense and liabilities of the City of Deary for said Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2026, authorizing a levy of sufficient tax upon the taxable property and specifying the objects and purchases for which said appropriation is made.
- 8. ACTION ITEM- City Council to consider approval of Resolution #257, which would increase water base rates by 4.5% from \$46.20 to \$48.28. New rates to go into effect October 1, 2025.
- 9. ACTION ITEM- City Council to consider approval of Resolution #258, which would increase sewer base rates 4% from \$61.76 to \$64.23. New rates to go into effect October 1, 2025.
- 10. ACTION ITEM- City Council to consider approval of Resolution #259, which would increase sanitation base rates by 4% for all bin collection services. Base rates for bin collection services, as follows:

35-gallon bins to increase from \$24.74 to \$25.73. 65-gallon bins to increase from \$29.66 to \$30.85. 95-gallon bins to increase from \$34.49 to \$35.87. 1-yard bins to increase from \$85.15 to \$88.56.

2-yard bins to increase from \$147.94 to \$153.86. 3-yard bins to increase from \$207.60 to \$215.90. 4-yard bins to increase from \$275.26 to \$286.27. New rates to go into effect October 1, 2025.
