PLANT CARE:

- Planting seeds
- Watering
- Weeding herb beds
- Grooming (deadheading, pruning, etc.)
- Monitoring for insects and diseases
- Fertilizing
- Harvesting

CLEANING & MAINTENANCE:

- Cleaning in and around the garden (sweeping, raking, etc.)
- Weeding garden beds and paths
- Mowing
- Maintaining a clean work environment

PROCESSING:

- Moving harvested herbs into and out of dehydrators
- Storing dehydrated herbs
- Checking quality of product

BASIC QUALIFICATIONS:

- Positive attitude and a high energy level
- Ability to stand, bend, lift, dig, rake, etc.
- Ability to lift 40 lbs occasionally
- Ability to withstand weather conditions (heat, humidity, cold, wind, rain, etc.)

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Existing plant knowledge or gardening/landscaping experience
- Prior experience working with people with intellectual, developmental, and physical disabilities
