



Famille Perrin Châteauneuf du Pape Rouge Les Sinards 2021

Famille Perrin, one of the most renowned winemaking families in the Rhône Valley and the family behind the renowned Château de Beaucastel and Miraval estates, is celebrated for crafting wines of exceptional quality and character. The 2021 vintage of Famille Perrin Châteauneuf du Pape Les Sinards offers an elegant and complex wine that captures the essence of this prestigious appellation.

Vineyard and Terroir

- Location: The wine is made from young Beaucastel vines (under 20 years old) and two neighboring vineyards: one south-west facing Syrah vineyard from the Clos de Châteauneuf-du-Pape, and another at Le Grès, 4 km from Beaucastel.
- **Soil Type**: Miocene marine deposits covered with alpine diluvium (rounded pebbles), with one parcel on Urgonian limestone. This contributes to the wine's complexity and minerality.
- **Viticulture Practices**: Sustainable and organic farming methods are employed to ensure minimal environmental impact.





Winemaking

- **Harvest**: Maturity checks begin in August, and grapes are tasted regularly to determine the optimum harvest date. Each variety is harvested separately.
- Vinification: The Syrah is partially vinified in whole clusters, and the remainder, along with the Grenache, is destemmed. Fermentation takes place in wooden and stainless-steel vats using the same methods as Château de Beaucastel wines. The wines are then blended and aged in foudres for 2 years.

Tasting Notes

- Appearance: Beautiful garnet-red color with shiny reflections.
- Aroma: A complex and warm aromatic bouquet with notes of leather.
- **Palate**: Elegant with delicious aromas of dried fruit, dates, dried figs, and candied grapes.
- Finish: Long and refined.
- **Aging Potential**: Can be enjoyed now but will evolve beautifully over 5 to 10 years.

Food Pairing

 Recommended Pairings: Perfect with with game and truffle or mushroom-based dishes.

Sustainable Practices and Certifications

- **Organic Farming**: Famille Perrin practices organic viticulture, ensuring respect for the environment and the vineyard's natural balance.
- **Sustainable Winemaking**: Emphasis on sustainable practices throughout the winemaking process, minimizing the use of chemicals and ensuring a reduced environmental impact.
