READING FROM THE EPISTLES - 2 Timothy 2.1-15

You then, my child, be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus and what you have heard from me through many witnesses entrust to faithful people who will be able to teach others as well. Share in suffering like a good soldier of Christ Jesus. No one serving in the Army gets entangled in

everyday affairs; the soldier's aim is to please the enlisting officer and in the case of an athlete, no one is crowned without competing according to the rules. It is the farmer who does the work who ought to have the first share of the crops. Think over what I say, for the Lord will give you understanding in all things. Remember Jesus Christ, raised from the dead, a descendant of David - that is my gospel, for which I suffer hardship, even to the point of being chained like a criminal; but the word of God is not chained. Therefore I endure everything for the sake of the elect, so that they may also obtain the salvation that is in Christ Jesus, with eternal glory. The saying is sure: If we have died with Him, we will also live with Him; if we endure, we will also reign with Him; if we deny Him, He will also deny us; if we are faithless, He remains faithful - for He cannot deny Himself. Remind them of this, and warn them before God that they are to avoid wrangling over words, which does no good but only ruins those who are listening. Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved by Him, a worker who has no need to be ashamed, rightly explaining the Word of Truth.

GOSPEL LESSON - Luke 17.11-19

On the way to Jerusalem Jesus was going through the region between Samaria and Galilee. As He entered a village, ten lepers approached Him. Keeping their distance, they called out, saying, "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!" When He saw them, He said to them, "Go and show yourselves to the priests" and as they went, they were made clean. Then one of them, when he saw that he was healed, turned back, praising God with a loud voice. He prostrated himself at Jesus' feet and thanked Him {and he was a Samaritan!}. Then Jesus asked, "Were not ten made clean? But the other nine, where are they? Was none of them found to return and give praise to God except this foreigner?" Then [Jesus] said to him, "Get up and go on your way; your Faith has made you well."

This is the Word of the Lord!

CONFESSION OF FAITH

{From The Augsburg Confession}

WE BELIEVE that...there is one divine essence who is named God and *truly is* God, Three Persons in the same One essence, equally powerful, equally eternal: God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit. All Three are one divine essence, eternal, undivided, unending, of immeasurable power, wisdom, and goodness, the Creator and Preserver of all things, visible and invisible...**WE BELIEVE** that God the Son became a human being, born of the Virgin Mary, and that the two natures, the divine and the human, are so inseparably united in one person that there is one Christ. He is true God and true human being who truly was born, suffered, crucified, died, and buried to be a sacrifice, not only for [our] sin...but also to conciliate God’s wrath. Christ descended into Hell, rose from the dead on the third day, ascended into Heaven, and is sitting at the right hand of [the Father] to rule and reign forever over all creatures, so that through the Holy Spirit He may make holy, purify, strengthen, and comfort all who believe in Him, and to distribute to them life, other gifts and benefits, and shield and protect them against the devil and sin.
