Sign In Fees:	\$40.00 per car. NOTE: Any out of town driver(s) not a member of a MWT club must pay an annual \$25 fee at their first MWT event.
NOTE:	3 cars constitute a class, with exception to the Rookies. If there are less than 3 cars, the class will <u>NOT</u> run. Each driver can enter 5 cars but no more than 3 cars per day.

PLEASE NOTE:

* Raceceivers ARE MANDATORY and will be utilized. Raceceivers determined not working during the race when brought in with the Meatball flag may be changed out if a raceceiver is readily available and driver will retain spot.

* 5 cars/2 minute Practice Round by Class. (3-minute practice round depending on car count) Clock will be paused once during the time for a caution.

* A pill draw (done at sign-in) will be used to determine heat race line-ups. Based on the number of cars in the class, there will be cars transferring directly to the A Main. Subsequent cars transfer to lower mains. Passing points will be utilized to determine A Main line-ups.

* All classes, except Rookie, will have no more than **12** cars per race. Note: Jr Honda & Jr Animal are not required. Rookies have 10 min. time limits and no more than 6 cars.

* There will be a break between Practice and Heats, Heats and Lower Mains & Lower Mains and A Mains. Cars must be in the hot chute and ready to race within the determined break time.

* 30 Second Warm Up prior to A Main races. Hard late out line enforced. No warm up before Heats or Lower Mains.

* 3 courtesy laps will be given to driver in work area once there is a line-up. Driver will be allowed out if down and rolling when the 1 to go is given.

* For engine changes after being sealed, must notify Tech Director for approval (Tower and Race Director will also need to be notified).

* For all issues that arise during event – see hosting club president (if not available, then see Larry McNulty MWT President or Hosting Club Vice President).

* In the event of a rain delay while cars are on the track, the drivers will be told to go to an area where their cars are in impound. The only changes that will be permitted will be checking air pressure. Once able to race again, drivers will line up using the last completed lap which is the same lap the race will start on. If any changes are needed, you must inform official before making any changes and the car will start on the tail.

* There is no video taping allowed in the hot chute area.

* Zero Tolerance policy in effect at all Midwest races & will honor any Midwest clubs code of conduct suspension as well.

* Engines must be painted and sealed any time prior to the completion of your heat race(s). Any engine changes notify Tech Director & Tower.

SAFETY CHECK. All cars must have a current year USAC safety decal affixed to the car. It is the sole responsibility of the handler to ensure a safety decal is affixed to the car. If you need a decal then you must bring your car to the local designated safety director for a safety inspection. Cars will be checked for a safety decal at the scales after races. If a car does not have a safety decal, the driver will receive a DQ.

There will be NO bikes, scooters, motorized scooters, roller blades or roller skates. The officials will have the authority to confiscate these items during the event and will return them after the event is complete or when the person(s) are leaving the premises.

Please make sure that all golf carts are operated by only adults 18 an over and when left vacant the keys are out of the ignition.

Line Up Summary: (Note: if more than 8 cars, then an additional heat is added)

1-12 CAR CLASS COUNT (1 or 2 Heats, top 12 to A Main)

13-16 CAR CLASS COUNT (2 Heats, top 6 in points to A Main; 1 lower main, transfer 4 to A Main)
17-20 CAR CLASS COUNT (3 Heats, top 6 in points to A Main; 2 lower mains, transfer 4 to A Main)
21-22 CAR CLASS COUNT (3 Heats, top 6 in points to A Main; 2 lower mains, transfer 4 to A Main)
23-28 CAR CLASS COUNT (3 or 4 Heats, top 6 in points to A Main; 3 lower mains, transfer 4 to A Main)

DIRECTIONS

Concession stand will be open Saturday and Sunday. We offer: cheeseburgers, hot dogs, wraps, chicken sticks, mini corn dogs, breaded mushrooms, fried pickles, mozzarella sticks, french fries, ice cream, blizzards, popsicles, candy, popcorn, soda, tea, Gatorade & water and more. We will have Breakfast items available as well. The concessions also carry: Ice, batteries & earbuds

Overnight Camping Fees (RV/Tent/Trailer):

There are no reservations for RV's by either the track or the fairgrounds. Full RV hook--up's are available at the far west end of the fairgrounds (they are approx. ½ mile away from the track), and full hook ups just north of the Mini Indy track. The state fairgrounds does require any person(s) physically staying overnight, anywhere on the fairgrounds, to pay the required amount, including a RV/camper/tent/trailer. This money is collected by a fairgrounds official. Fairgound officials will usually stop you as you enter the track to collect the camping fees. Otherwise, security will be around at all hours and will be checking passes no matter what time it is. Have your pass visible from the outside. Anyone that is staying overnight and refuses to pay will be escorted off of the fairgrounds by security. --One day camping pass is \$20 for no hook--up or electricity OR \$30 for full hook--up or electricity --Yearly passes are available for \$250.00 (if desired) The fairgrounds has started charging \$10 for anyone who is hooked to electricity per day, they will collect this not Mini Indy.

Indiana State Fairgrounds prohibits all fireworks and enforces restricted areas of the fairgrounds which will be discussed in the driver's meeting. Any violator's will be removed by fairground security for the remainder of the event.

Driving directions:

I-65 North (from Louisville, KY; Columbus, IN)

Take I-65 North to I-70 East to Keystone Avenue (exit #85B) Take Keystone Avenue north to 38th Street. Turn left (west) on 38th Street.

I-65 South (from Chicago, IL; Lafayette, IN)

Take I-65 South to the 38th Street exit. Continue east to the Fairgrounds entrance. I-70 East (from St. Louis, MO; Terre Haute, IN) Take I-70 East to Keystone Avenue (exit #85B). Take Keystone Avenue north to 38th Street. Turn left (west) on 38th Street.

I-70 West (from Columbus, OH; Richmond, IN)

Take I-70 West to Keystone Avenue (exit #85B). Take Keystone Avenue north to 38th Street. Turn left (west) on 38th Street.

I-69 South (from Detroit, MI; Fort Wayne, IN)

I-69 South becomes Binford Boulevard (SR37) which becomes Fall Creek Parkway. The Fairgrounds is located just north of 38th Street on Fall Creek Parkway.

I-74 West (from Cincinnati, OH)

I-74 West (from Cincinnati, OH) Take I-74 West to I-465 North. Take I-465 North to I-70 West to Keystone Avenue (exit #85B). Take Keystone Avenue north to 38th Street. Turn left (west) on 38th Street.

From Indianapolis International Airport

Take the Indianapolis Airport Expressway to 70 East to Keystone Avenue (exit #85B). Take Keystone Avenue north to 38th St. Turn left (west) on 38th St. and continue to Fairgrounds entrance.
