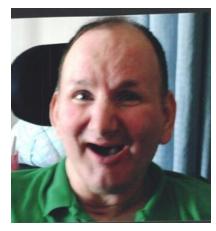
Ennis A Haley (June 15, 1954 - July 31, 2014)
