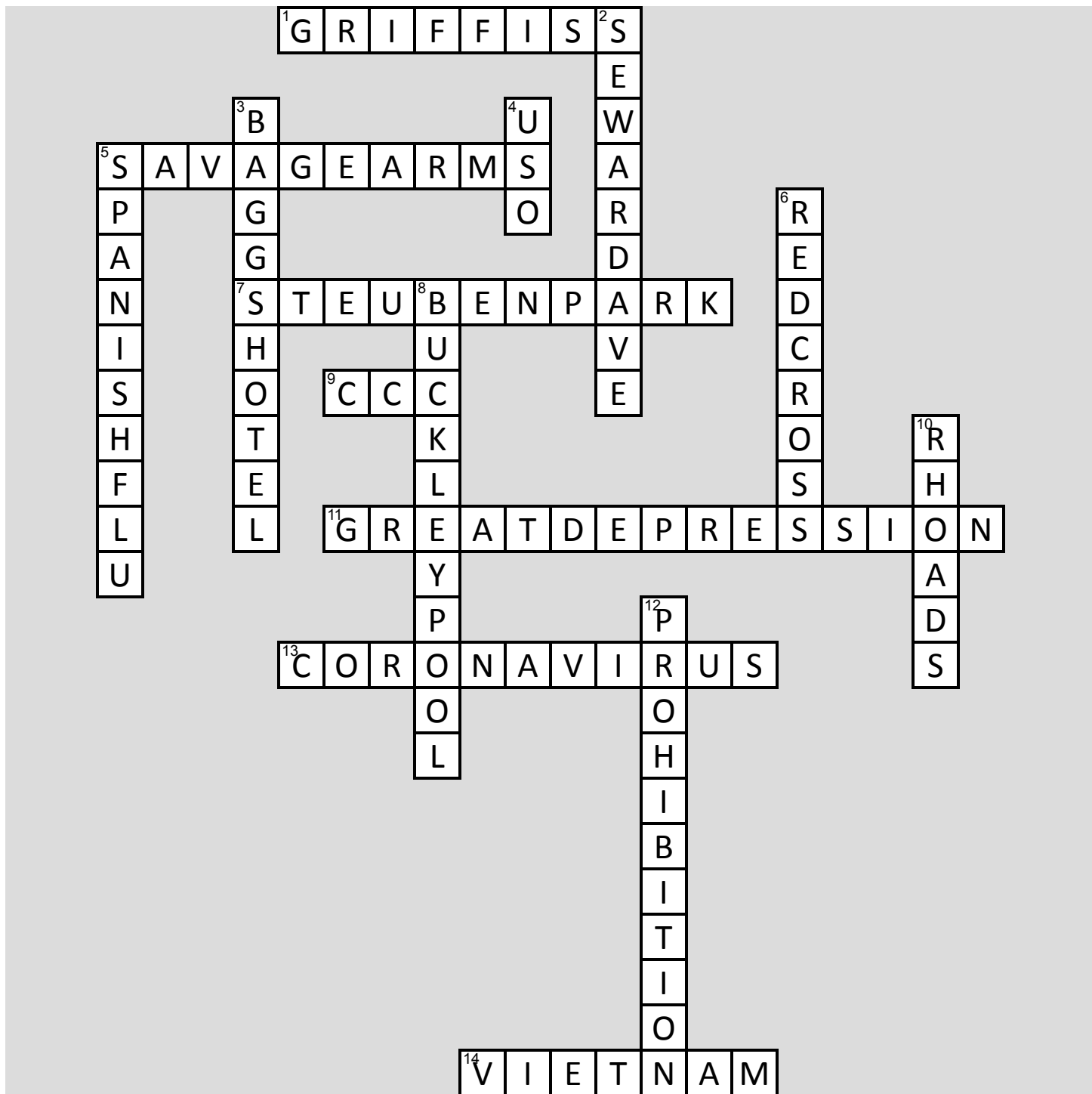

- 1** This is an Air Base that was built in 1948 and named after the first American killed in line of duty during World War II.
- 5** In 1914, World War I began and 70,000 machine guns were ordered from this Utica factory.

- 9** This New Deal program put young people to work. A camp for them was established in Hawkinsville, Oneida County.

- 2** German war prisoners were housed in a former factory on this street in Utica.
- 3** In 1932, Maria Proctor had this dilapidated downtown Utica building razed, giving work to dozens.
- 4** In 1942, a lounge for military personnel was opened in Union Station by this non-profit corp.
- 5** This epidemic reached the Mohawk Valley in 1918.
- 6** During the 1918 epidemic this organization systematized the furnishing of physicians and supplies in Utica.
- 8** The Works Progress Administration (WPA) funds allowed construction of this municipal swim site in 1937.
- 10** This hospital was opened in 1943 by the US Army to care for soldiers wounded from fighting in N. Africa.
- 12** The period when consumption and production of alcohol was illegal.
