RCIA News: The Scrutinies

The Elect (unbaptized) will celebrate the laying on of hands during three weekend Masses: Saturday, March 19th at 5:30 p.m., Sunday, March 27th at 9:00 a.m., and Sunday, April 3rd at 11:30 a.m. The Scrutinies are prayers meant to uncover and heal all that is weak, sinful and defective in the heart, then to strengthen all that is upright, strong and good.

We celebrate the Scrutinies with the gospel readings of the Woman at the Well, the Man Born Blind, and the Raising of Lazarus. The Elect and Candidates dismiss during the Liturgy of the Eucharist to Break Open the Word. They examine their lives in light of the gospel teachings which are so rich in helping us to discern the call to discipleship.

They look forward to the day of their baptism when they can celebrate the entire liturgy with our Saint Olaf community.
