DESCRIPTION: Quite rare high-end Shakespeare Proline Condor all-purpose recurve. This is the shorter 56" version. Great looking and performing bow. Original condition. Phenolic and select hardwood riser. Comfortable grip. Factory installed side plate button. Factory installed stabilizer bushing. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Beveled arrow shelf. 5-layer tip overlays. Overlays and tips are in great condition. 2 filled sight screw holes on the back of the riser (see pic on p. 4). No chips, dings or cracks. No crazing or stress cracks. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decals are in good shape. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age.
