Day 1 Tuesday, June 6, 2023

- 6:45 AM Depart from Liverpool for second pick up
7:00 AM Our motor coach will arrive at New York State United Teachers (4983 Brittonfield Pkwy, East Syracuse, NY 13057) for boarding
7:30 AM We will depart for Cape Cod. We will make a coffee and lunch stop in route (on your own). *I have allowed 2 hours for stopping and traffic*
3:00 PM Welcome to the sandy shores of Cape Cod. Extending some 70 miles into the sea, the Cape is home to both natural beauty and quaint colonial villages. You can walk pristine beaches, revel in the arts and culture, and reclaim your childhood memories of seashells, sandcastles, and saltwater taffy. Upon arrival check in at our **hotel – Hampton Inn Cape Cod – West Yarmouth**. We're on Yarmouth's Main Street, a mile from Colonial Acres Beach and the port for ferries to Nantucket and Martha's Vineyard is just over a mile away. Relax in our indoor or outdoor pools and enjoy free hot breakfast and Wi-Fi.

6:00 PM **Dinner buffet** included this evening at the **Daniel Webster Inn** - always a renowned experience. You are now at the extreme tip of Cape Cod. Formerly known as the "Province Lands" the pilgrims landed here first before they decided to settle across the Bay in Plymouth. Take some time to enjoy the wonderful variety of restaurants, shops and galleries that make this artists/fishermen village so unique. *Lunch is on your own*
2:30 PM While in Provincetown admission included on a **Dune Tour** – you will ride along the shoreline of the protected lands of the Cape Cod National Seashore. Your guide will point out the "dune shacks" where famous artists and writers became inspired to create their art
3:30 PM Depart for hotel
4:30 PM Estimated arrival time back at your hotel.
6:30 PM **Lobster Dinner at Yarmouth House Restaurant** - roots trace their origins back to the old country and follow a route through Canada before settling in along Route 28. The Yarmouth House Restaurant was founded in 1978 by the Kounadis family patriarch, Gerry Kounadis. With hard work and dedication, the restaurant has become one of Cape Cod's favorites, as it remains today. **Your entrée choices are: (please make your selection at the time of reservation)**
