

# **MINNIE EDITH (STIRRETT) WILLIAMS**

## **1903-1990**

Minnie E. Williams, age 86 of Elkton, passed away Wednesday, April 11, at the Huron County Medical Care Facility, Bad Axe following a brief illness.

She was born November 30, 1903 in Chandler Township daughter of the late Henry and Minnie (Kleinhardt) Steinman.
