- 2. Parents/Guardians complete Affidavit Concerning Pupil Residency
- 3. Application is checked for completeness
  - 4. Correspondence is sent to Parents/Guardians with incomplete applications
  - 5. Applications forwarded to Superintendent, who acts in Stratton School Official role to determine residency of applicant.
  - 6. Superintendent informs applicant of Residency determination
    - a. Parent/Guardian is provided a written document that explains the procedure for challenging the Superintendent's determination by making an appeal to the Stratton School Board.
    - b. Parent/Guardian is provided a written document that explains the right to seek intervention for the Vermont Agency of Education to obtain a temporary order.
  - 7. If Parent/Guardian appeals to the Board, the Board will convene a hearing.
    - a. A School District representative will present the case for determining non-residency.
    - b. The Parent/Guardian must present information to the Board to support the claim of residency.
    - c. The Board will act as fact finder and make a determination based on the information provided.
    - d. The Board's decision may be appealed to the Vermont Agency of Education for final determination.
