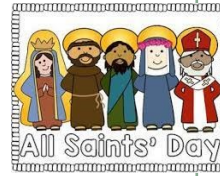

On Sunday, *November 3* at the 9:00 AM Mass we will celebrate with the inquirers in OCIA *The Rite Of Acceptance* and *The Rite of Welcoming*. Assembling publicly for the first time, these inquirers will declare their intentions to the Church - and the Church accepts them as persons who intend to become its members. In the Rite of Acceptance, a change of identity takes place: those previously known as inquirers become catechumens. This rite is “the first consecration by the Church” of those seeking Christian initiation. They are literally marked with the cross of Christ as God’s own. Please make them feel welcome and pray for them.
