Keep in mind, this year's newsletter will once again have write-up for every CFB and NFL game along with CFB power ratings and all the opening bets we made at Circa. If you want CFB picks, but can't afford the \$499 VIP, we recommend betting our power ratings on page 6. For the past eight seasons we have posted computer projected lines for every game. **Games where there was of difference of more than 3 points saw our computer lines actually beat the Vegas line at a 506-441-14 (53.4%) clip!** That's pretty solid and actually better than our own handicapping in some seasons. Keep in mind, these computer lines don't take into consideration off-the-field factors like revenge or flat spots or if there are late-week injuries. They are basically a power-rating number difference between the two teams that also takes into consideration the home field advantage.

The next issue comes out Wednesday, September 3rd at 3pm ET! It will include Week 1 NFL write-ups along with Week 2 CFB.

Games in Rotation Order

Thursday, August 28th

NC STATE 37 East Carolina 23. A rematch of last year's Military Bowl which saw East Carolina win 26-21 as 7-point underdogs. There was a late-game brawl between the two teams and NC State will be without their starting NT Cleveland for the first half. NC State is the more experienced team and should be motivated here. We saw a couple "sharp" groups hit NC State -11.5 earlier in the week but we are passing at current. Market loves OVER.

Boise State 34 SOUTH FLORIDA 27. The best Group of 5 game of the weekend. Boise loses All-American RB Jeanty but rank in the Top 15 in returning production and are the clear favorites to grab the G5 playoff spot again. USF also ranks high in returning production and could be a surprise team (we bet them 9/1 to win AAC). The market loves USF here but we like Boise and UNDER at current.

UCF 36 Jacksonville State 18. We're not a fan of either new head coach. A ton of roster turnover here makes this a tough handicap for us. Scott Frost returns where he led UCF to a 13-0 record in 2017. Meanwhile, Charles Kelly gets his first HC job after serving as an assistant the last 35 years. The market has hated Jacksonville St this entire off-season and this week we've seen this line move from UCF -17 to -20.5. Our ratings lean Jacksonville St at current.

Wyoming 28 AKRON 21. Wyoming is the more experienced team but making a unique trip across the country. The Cowboys had their worst team in a decade last year and lost three defensive starters post-spring to the portal. Akron is the first team since Idaho in 2012 to be ineligible for a bowl due to bad APR scores. Will that impact them this year? We bet Akron earlier this summer but we would lean Wyoming at current (numbers do matter).

RUTGERS 33 Ohio 18. Ohio is off their first 11-win season in school history and their first MAC championship since 1968. They lost their head coach and almost their entire defense but return their star QB Navarro. Rutgers could be sneaky good this year but their record might not reflect it (tough schedule). They rank in the Top 10 in returning production. The market loves the favorite and OVER. We're passing on both after the big line moves.

† **Nebraska 28 Cincinnati 21.** @Arrowhead Stadium in Kansas City, MO. A week 1 matchup that should be getting more love nationally. On paper, this is the best Nebraska team in a decade. Meanwhile, Cincinnati enters the season on a 5-game losing streak and head coach Satterfield is on the hot seat. The market loves the OVER here as the thought is new Nebraska OC Holgorsen will play with more tempo and the Nebraska defense looks weaker. We disagree and lean UNDER.

MINNESOTA 31 Buffalo 14. The market has been back and forth on this one this summer. A lot of money on Buffalo but a "sharp" group took Minnesota last week. We bet both teams OVER their win totals this summer as both have manageable schedules. Our power ratings prefer Minnesota but it is tough laying this kind of number with a new QB against the MAC's best defense.

WISCONSIN 30 Miami, OH 12. Miami, OH returns ZERO starters on offense but we like what they did in the portal including bringing in QB Finn. On the other side, this is Fickell's best team but the Badgers play the toughest schedule in the country and might struggle to make a bowl. Wisconsin is the much more experienced team and our power ratings like them here. However, it's tough laying three scores with the lowest total on the board. We lean OVER.

Friday, August 29th

SAN JOSE STATE 33 Central Michigan 19. We thought San Jose coach Niumatalolo did a great job last year. We like this year's team and could see them favored in as many as 10 games. CMU has a new coach in Matt Drinkall. He inherits a decent situation as CMU has underachieved the last couple of years and returns more production than most first-year head coaches. However, our ratings like San Jose here.

† **Appalachian State 28 Charlotte 21.** @Bank of America Stadium in Charlotte, NC. We like Charlotte's hire of Tim Albin but he brought few Ohio transfers with him. We don't like the Loggains hire for Appalachian State. Two new coaches with a ton of roster turnover makes this a difficult handicap. A couple of market influencers have given out the UNDER here and we've seen some support for the underdog. We're passing.

WAKE FOREST 34 Kennesaw State 17. Hey, what do you know... another game involving a pair of new head coaches with massive roster turnover. It makes this year's week 1 one of the more difficult weeks to handicap in recent memory. Both teams do return some experience on defense. We like the Jake Dickert hire for Wake but this is going to be a tough first season. We're unsure about the new Kennesaw coach.

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

Auburn 29 BAYLOR 28. This is the best game of the weekend that no one is talking about. Both teams season win totals could be on the line and both coaches' tenures as well. We bet both teams OVER their win totals and both could be surprise factors in their conference races. Baylor returns 14 starters and ranks in the Top 10 in returning production. We bet a little Auburn ML trying to get in front of a market move but we'd prefer Baylor +3 here if it shows.

Unlv 37 SAM HOUSTON STATE 28. We have yet another game involving a pair of new coaches. However, both teams played last week. Neither impressed. UNLV almost lost outright as a 30.5-point favorite to Idaho State. The Rebels allowed 555 yards and were +3 in TO's. QB Colandrea did look good throwing for 195 and running for 93. Meanwhile, Sam Houston got out-gained 506-382 in a 17-point loss at WKU. You certainly have to downgrade UNLV more from the performances. We lean OVER here as we have two offensive-minded coaches and points were left on the field in both team's games last week.

Georgia Tech 29 COLORADO 23. This is a rare Week 1 matchup where we are high on one team this season (Georgia Tech) and low on another (Colorado). GT is the more experienced team and has the better coaching staff. Colorado loses the Heisman winner in WR/DB Hunter and has a major downgrade at QB. A couple of groups have hammered the UNDER in this game this week. We prefer GT.

MICHIGAN STATE 36 Western Michigan 15. We think the Spartans will be much improved in year two under HC Smith. However, the schedule will make it difficult for them to top last year's win total. WMU returns little experience like most MAC teams. MSU has taken some money this week and our ratings agree.

Saturday, August 30th

PURDUE 33 Ball State 18. It's going to sound like a broken record but another week one game with two new head coaches, new rosters and new schemes. We really like new coach Barry Odom from UNLV. However, the Boilers return just one starter and bring in 69 new players. Ball State's new coach comes over from Butler and will feature more QB run. Tough to handicap although someone in the market loves Purdue this week. We don't agree and lean Ball State.

PENN STATE 51 Nevada 7. Penn State is our No. 1 team in our power ratings to start the season. The Nittany Lions return the most proven talent and have an advantageous schedule. However, we didn't bet them to win the National Title as we still have questions on whether HC Franklin and QB Allar can win 3-4 big games in a row. Nevada is in their worst stretch in school history off three straight 10-loss seasons. They were better than their record last year (2-6 in one score games). Typically, we'd take the dog here but Franklin tends to know the point-spread and isn't afraid of scoring late.

INDIANA 40 Old Dominion 16. Indiana is coming off a school-record 11-win season. However, they return five players who garner 1st-team All-Big Ten mention and we still have them power-rated in our Top 20. We're high on this ODU team as they return their tackling machine LB Henderson who missed last year due to injury. This game has barely moved in the market this year. We lean OVER.

MICHIGAN 44 New Mexico 6. Michigan will turn to 5-star true freshman QB Bryce Underwood. Despite the inexperience, he will be much better than what UM had at QB last season. The Wolverines still have a Top 10 defense. We like New Mexico's hire of Jason Eck from Idaho but this year will be a struggle with only one starter back on offense. How do the Lobos score? We like Michigan.

Temple 26 MASSACHUSETTS 23. Tell us if you've heard this before. A week one game involving two new head coaches. Temple returns more production (No. 68 vs No. 125) and we're big fans of new head coach KC Keeler who wins everywhere he goes. We think their offense could surprise and we bet them in this game. UMass has joined the MAC this year as they try to find a way to compete at this level. They have never won more than 4 games in a season since joining the FBS in 2012. We lean with Temple under a FG.

† **Tennessee 32 Syracuse 17.** @Mercedes-Benz Stadium in Atlanta, GA. With eight returning starters and one of the more underrated DC's in CFB, we think Tennessee's defense is playoff caliber this year. We don't feel the same way about their offense which we downgraded at every position. We also downgraded Syracuse's power rating significantly on offense. We you add everything up, you see why we gave UNDER 53.5 to clients a couple weeks ago.

MARYLAND 38 Florida Atlantic 23. FAU has a new coach in Zach Kittley who brings with him QB Veltkamp from WKU. The expectation is they will be much improved offensively. Maryland went 4-8 last year and had six guys taken in the NFL Draft. Can you say underachieving? We've seen money on FAU and OVER but we aren't involved.

VIRGINIA 35 Coastal Carolina 22. UVA has gotten some love in the summer markets. They bring in a nice transfer portal class and have an advantageous schedule. However, we don't like HC Elliott and QB Morris. Coastal has major roster turnover yet again with 58 new players. This is a game where we don't have much interest.

OHIO STATE 24 Texas 23. One of the biggest opening games in CFB history. A rematch of last year's semifinal which saw Ohio State win 28-14 as 6-point favorites. This game would be even bigger in the 4-team playoff or BCS era but now teams can afford multiple losses. We have three key questions. The most obvious but most important one is which inexperienced QB makes the fewest mistakes? Second, Texas' OL and Ohio State's DL are the two most inexperienced units. Who wins that battle? Finally, we think new Ohio State OC Hartline and new DC Patricia are clear downgrades from Kelly and Knowles. How big though? Our ratings like Ohio State, our gut says Texas. We gave out UNDER to VIP clients.

GEORGIA 47 Marshall 7. UGA might not have the star power as recent editions but we think HC Kirby Smart prefers the Bulldogs flying a little under the radar this off-season with all the hype surrounding Texas, Penn State and Clemson. On the other side, we've downgraded Marshall's power rating more than any team in the country. Georgia can name their score.

KENTUCKY 28 Toledo 19. Toledo took a lot of money in the market this summer. We agreed with the initial move when it was above "10". We think the Rockets are the best team in the MAC on paper (like most seasons). Meanwhile, we're very down on Kentucky. Numbers matter though and we bet Kentucky when the market bottomed out at -7. At current we're passing.

UTAH STATE 33 Utah 28. We like the hire of Bronco Mendenhall who returns to the state where he played and coached for so long. Mendenhall did wonders at New Mexico last year and the Utah State program has much more upside. UTEP has brought in talented recruiting and transfer classes the last two years but remains an unknown under HC Walden. They will start former 5-star QB Malachi Nelson. We aren't involved here but a group we respect likes Utah State.

WASHINGTON 38 Colorado State 16. Washington is a team we that could be flying under the radar this season. We expect them to be much improved in year two under Fisch and have won 20 consecutive home games. We're down on Colorado State this year relative to market (gave out UNDER 6.5 wins to VIP clients). Market likes Washington here and we agree.

ARIZONA 35 Hawaii 17. This is a one-factor handicap. Will Hawaii QB Alejado play or not? He did not partake in Tuesday's practice but HC Timmy Chang says he will play. We have our doubts and so does the market. This is the biggest line move of the summer (opened Arizona -10.5) and that includes Hawaii's dramatic win over Stanford last Saturday. It's a flat spot, they're traveling and there is no "game under belt" advantage in CFB. It's better to have film on your opponent than having played a game (57% trend last 25 years, bet on team playing game No. 1 vs team playing game No. 2).

FRESNO STATE 26 Georgia Southern 25. Fresno State did not look good in week zero at Kansas as their new ground-oriented attack managed just 37 rush yards and the passing sputtered after the first two drives. We are not fans of this Matt Entz hire. Georgia Southern could have their best team yet under Clay Helton. The market has flipped favorites here. We're indifferent.

Utah 28 UCLA 24. Earlier this summer, there was a lot of love for Utah in this matchup between former Pac-12 foes. We were hoping to see a "7" to bet on UCLA but it didn't show and it looks like it won't show with some Bruin money leaking into the market this week. We do think Utah will be one of the most improved teams in the country especially on offense. We did like how UCLA finished last season but they don't return much from last year.

TULANE 24 Northwestern 21. We think Northwestern is undervalued in the markets and we gave out OVER 3.5 wins to VIP clients. We think QB Stone will be an upgrade and we like the defensive personnel. Tulane will miss QB Mensah and too much was made of the summer transfer of BYU QB Retzlaff. While our ratings lean Tulane, we think Northwestern is a live dog here.

Mississippi State 38 SOUTHERN MISS 24. This is another game where we think the market got too cute. We've upgraded Southern Miss more than any team in the country this off-season. That's despite them having a new coach and returning only 5 starters. Obviously, they've upgraded with HC Huff and a bunch of players coming with him from Marshall including QB Braxton. However, we also feel Miss St is much improved.

OLE MISS 47 Georgia State 12. If you check out our CFB Preview (\$40), this game had the biggest power ratings disparity. The line got as high as Ole Miss -39 but a very respected group came in big on Georgia State on Monday. We agree. The problem is Lane Kiffin isn't afraid to run up the score and may want to give his young QB extra snaps even in a blowout to build confidence.

TEXAS STATE 35 Eastern Michigan 22. An intriguing Group of 5 games here. Texas State underachieved greatly last year as they were favored in all 12 regular season games last year and only went 7-5. We don't think this year's team will be as good but they might have a similar record. EMU is always pesky in the road underdog role with a 30-11 ATS mark since 2016. We bet EMU at +14.5.

Alabama 32 FLORIDA STATE 17. We upgraded FSU's power rating more than any other Power 4 conference team (see next page). Last year was a disaster but we like their transfer portal class and also like their new coordinators (Gus Malzahn and DC Tony White). However, we think Alabama is also much improved this year. The Crimson Tide are a legit National Title contender. They have as much talent as any roster in the country and we'll give coach DeBoer a mulligan for year one. We bet Alabama in the spring, gave them out to all customers in our spring guide and still like them even after the line move.

TEXAS A&M 40 Utsa 18. Like most seasons, our off-season power ratings like Texas A&M. They have a Top 10 recruiting profile, return all 5 starters on the offensive line and rank in the Top 10 in returning production. We also like HC Elko. How much are they going to show before the big game at Notre Dame in a couple weeks? UTSA should have one of the better Group of 5 offenses thanks to the return of 9 starters. We're passing.

UL-LAFAYETTE 28 Rice 17. Rice has a new HC and will be running a version of the option offense this year. ULL has had all off-season to prep but with an expected slower tempo, we've seen the market bet the UNDER and the dog in this game all summer. We do like ULL's new QB Walker Howard but there's a lot of unknown here.

USC 48 Missouri State 13. We're big believers in this USC team this year. We gave out OVER 7.5 wins to VIP clients as we think this will be their best defense in quite some time. Keep an eye on their two DT transfers from the SEC. Missouri State will be playing their first game as a FBS school. They have a solid QB in Jacob Clark not much else.

CLEMSON 30 Lsu 26. Texas at Ohio State might be the biggest game of Week 1, but this might be the most important game. A loss would be devastating to either considering their high expectations and recent struggles in big games. LSU's defense is improved but will get tested here vs an improved Clemson passing attack. LSU's OL returns only one starter, how will it hold up against Clemson's DL? Both teams have struggled in season openers recently. Clemson has lost 3 of 4 while LSU has lost 5 straight. Both coaches need this game (Brian Kelly more) and both teams have legit Heisman candidates at QB. We bet Clemson early this off-season but would prefer the UNDER at current.

OREGON STATE 27 California 24. Another former "Pac-12 After Dark" matchup. The game is vital to both programs and also could swing a season win total. We don't like what's going on at Cal this off-season. Who is in charge of the program? Is it head coach Wilcox or GM Rivera? They lost their two best players post-spring in RB Ott and TE Endries. Oregon State should be improved in year two under Bray. Cal did destroy Oregon State last year 44-7 but the Beavers are much more experienced and playing at home.

Sunday, August 31st

† South Carolina 30 Virginia Tech 21. @Mercedes-Benz Stadium in Atlanta, GA. The "Beamer Bowl" as South Carolina head coach Shane Beamer plays the school where his dad Frank coached for 30 years and where Shane played. We don't like either team relative to expectation this year and bet both teams under their win total. Lots of love for the OVER in this game but we prefer South Carolina at current.

Notre Dame 24 MIAMI, FL 23. ND's last 6 trips to Miami: 0-6 straight up losing by 28 ppg and 0-6 ATS failing to cover by 24.5 ppg. Most important factor in this game is new ND QB CJ Carr making his first start. If he play a clean game, ND is the right side...if he doesn't Miami wins outright. We prefer UNDER. ND will be conservative, we love their defense and Miami QB Beck and the young WR's will take a few games to gel. Lots of running.

Monday, September 1st

TCU 30 NORTH CAROLINA 26. What a way to close with Bill Belichick making his college head coaching debut. We aren't buying him, his staff or the roster. TCU is a team we think is being undervalued in the market and bet them OVER 6.5 wins. Even after a big line move, we'd prefer the TCU side here.

For the past eight seasons we have posted computer projected lines for every game on Wednesday. **Games where there was of difference of more than 3 points saw our computer lines actually beat the Vegas line at a 506-441-14 (53.4%) clip! Last week our computer went 1-1.** That's pretty solid and actually better than our own handicapping in some seasons. Keep in mind, these computer lines don't take into consideration off-the-field factors like revenge or flat spots or if there are late-week injuries. They are basically a power-rating number difference between the two teams that also takes into consideration the home field advantage.

Of the 6 games where our computer is off more than 3 points compared to the Vegas line (highlighted), our favorite team this week to back would be **Michigan -34.5**.

The Comp column is the computer projected line and the Diff column is the difference between the Vegas line and the Computer line. "+" numbers in the difference column say back the underdog. "-" numbers in the difference column say back the favorite. Let us know if you have questions.

We think it's the best value bets we make all week. 2020 was the first season where we tracked every single bet we made and posted them in the weekly newsletters. We were very pleased with our 119-76-3 (61%) record on these Sunday bets with an average line value of 2.6 ppg! In 2021, we were 224-196-55 (53.3%) vs the Circa openers with an average line value of 1.8 ppg. In 2022, we were 314-262-14 (54.5%, CLV 417-122-51 +1.65 ppg). In 2023, we were 405-358-6 (53.4%, CLV 577-137-55 +2.09 ppg). Week 1 lines came out in May for all the FBS vs FBS games. Below is some of what we bet already.
