Veritas introductory Program or (VIP) is designed for 4's and young 5's. The program will engage students through rich literature and meaningful bible stories, which will serve as the basis for our daily learning.

Active learning opportunities will focus on 5 cores areas:

- 1) Faith
- 2) Family
- 3) Fluency in the Fundamentals
- 4) Friendship
- 5) Fun

Faith: Proverbs 1:10, Proverbs 2:10-11, and 2 Timothy 3:25

Students will understand that discovering the Creator is the first step in gaining wisdom. Daily bible stories, crafts, prayers, scripture memory, worship songs taught by professing faculty will lay a firm spiritual foundation.

Family: Proverbs 1:8, Proverbs 6:20, Proverbs 15:20, and Ephesians 6:1-2

We live in a world in which the family unit, especially parental authority, is under constant attack. VIP students will receive continuous encouragement and instruction regarding God's design for the family unit and a child's role within that unit. This is a special time for our young students to learn the value of "following," so they will become Christ-centered servant leaders as they mature.

Fluency in the Fundamentals: Proverbs 1:5, Isaiah 28: 9-10, Colossians 3:23, Proverbs 18:15

Success in academics as well as a child's social and emotional well-being is predicated on early learning. As a result, the V.I.P. will focus on ensuring students develop:

- 1) An understanding that wisdom is God-ordained and gaining knowledge its precept
- 2) Pre-reading/Literacy Skills
- 3) Fine and Gross Motor Skills
- 4) Communication and Listening skills
- 5) Independence skills
- 6) Early math skills
- 7) Basic Concepts and awareness skills
- 8) Curiosity for learning and problem-solving
- 9) Fine arts appreciation: visual, performing, and musical arts.

Healthy friendships will enable students to develop confidence, engage others for Christ, and create social connections that every child desires to feel loved and valued. At Veritas Florida, we believe that all students – including our youngest ones – should first understand they are loved unconditionally by their Father and that He gives us the ability to love others. Through VIP, students will develop:

- 1) An understanding that God's Love and Word Should Guide our Actions
- 2) Responsibility for Personal Actions
