In Match Play, Wrobel defeats Grote 8 & 6 and Babo defeats Thiry, F. 3 & 1. Courteous Player of the Year goes to Greg Cavallo who allowed the group behind them to play through on the 6th hole... There were two people who shot 50-34. The last group had 2 double hits on the day. Dennis Grote double hits a putt and Thiry, F. double hits a 3-wood TEE SHOT on #8 into the hazard left. Fitz takes a 16 on #6, but on a positive side only loses 1 ball! (see Cavallo above). Good to see Luke Wolters in NJ for a round of golf.
