Local Law Numbered 2 of the Year 2018

A Local Law amending Local Law Number 1 of the year 2006 entitled "A Local Law regulating the sale, consumption and possession of alcoholic beverages in public places within the Village of Cohocton, New York."

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Cohocton as follows:

1) Article IV of Local Law Number 1 of the year 2006 is amended to read in its entirety:

IV. EXCEPTIONS

The foregoing prohibitions shall not apply to the service, consumption, or possession for the purpose of consumption of any alcoholic beverage in any public place where the same has been authorized by a license or a permit under the laws and regulations of this State and pursuant to the regulations of the Village. However, from the period of October 1 through October 15 of each year, such license or permit will only be an exception to the foregoing prohibitions if the alcohol served, consumed or possessed is: 1) for sampling or tasting, with a serving size of two fluid ounces or less, and 2) consumed on-site of the vendor.

2) This local law shall take effect upon filing with the New York State Secretary of State.
