

DR. OTTO FRENZEL

PASSES AWAY

Death Occured at St. Mary's Hospital, Saginaw Last Friday.

Dr. Otto Frenzel died at St. Mary's hospital Saginaw Friday of last week. He went to the hospital two week previous and while at first his case was not considered serious it later developed that there was but little hope of his recovery and for the last week of his life, death was expected at most any time.

Dr. Frenzel was one of the oldest and best known physicians in the county. He located in Pigeon thirty-two years ago, shortly after graduating from the medical department of the Columbus (Ohio) University. He was recognized as a very able practitioner and always enjoyed a good practice.

Otto Frenzel was born in Mayville, Michigan fifty-two years ago. On September 26, 1892 he was united in marriage to Mary Helen Myers, who passed away two years ago this month. On December 31st last year he was united in marriage to Tillie Myers, who survives him. He is also survived by a father who resides in Saginaw.

Deceased was a member of Winsor Lodge F. & A. M. The Consistory at Bay City and Shrine at Saginaw and Eastern Star.

A short service was held at Saginaw Saturday which was attended by a number of Pigeon and Huron county friends, after which the remains were taken to Attica, N. Y. for burial.
