Our promise and dedication towards completing the Santuario in honor of Our Lady of Guadalupe and Mysteries of the Rosary perseveres and each day brings us closer to its completion. Gravel has been spread in front and around the east and west sides of the labyrinth. Trees (6) have been planted. As donations are received, more trees will be placed. We have also planted shrubs and flower bushes and surrounded the area with gravel. Adobe dedication plaques are now in place in the labyrinth courtyard and placement of plaques continue. Once all these are in place, merchants who have supported our project, will also be acknowledged. Each outlying mission will have its own mission statue displayed when funds are available. Please support the volunteers seeking contributions from your placita. Your continued patience & cooperation is greatly appreciated as we work with volunteers in this phase of our project. St. Augustine & Holy Family statues are now in place at the Santuario. In addition, statues of Our Lady Of Guadalupe and St. Juan Diego will be placed at the entrance and donations are being accepted to begin this phase. Placement of new trees will also be available to contributors interested in dedicating a tree in memory of a family member similar to what now exists on Veterans Boulevard entering the Village of Conejos. 



SCAN TO DONATE

Theme: Who Are We?

In daily life, we must be concerned about priorities. First things first! Prayer in the family and worship even in an expensive and luxurious church building are wonderful but not enough. A congregation as such must be socially concerned; otherwise it is not like salt in the community, not a city seen by all, not a light to those in town who walk in darkness. Two Sundays ago (3rd Sunday, the idea of discipleship and ministry by all was brought out. Today's Gospel suggests the same idea, but now by using metaphors: salt, a city set on a hill, and light.

The First Reading explains what our approach should be. Remove a few things out of your midst (oppression, malicious speech) and share whatever you have. "Then your light shall break forth like the dawn."

What are the priorities of your parish council? Is its first concern worship, some more expensive items for the sanctuary, and improvement of the parking lot? But are there poor and deprived in your community? What is done for the old and lonely?

Sharing time and yourself can be as important in our de-personalized society as sharing bread. It is the mark of Christians worth their salt, and their "justice shall endure forever" (Responsorial Psalm). What can you do? If you are not a member of your parish council, you are a constituent!

FIRST READING Is 58:7-10

[Charity]

The unknown prophet (composer of Is 56—66, called Third Isaiah) addresses Hebrews back from exile in Babylon. In their joy over newly found freedom, they have expected too much. God's people must seek something deeper and more genuine than just the experiences of being free. The writer goes into details of sharing, with the promise (also directed to us) that "then... your wound shall quickly be healed"

SECOND READING 1 Cor 2:1-5

[Power of the Spirit]

The Christian philosophy of life is defined as a sharing (First Reading), especially of self, a sharing that hurts and can be a cross ("Jesus Christ, and him crucified" as your example!). This is a kind of "wisdom" that many do not accept. Paul is aware that there are members in the congregation of Corinth who do not accept it either. Hence, he emphasizes that "faith [rests] not on human wisdom but on the power of God." We should pray for it constantly.


