1. What Is Being Built

1.1 BlackVault™ — The Sovereign AI Memory Layer

Constitutional Memory S.A. has developed BlackVault™ — enterprise AI governance middleware that enables any organisation to deploy artificial intelligence tools with complete data sovereignty. The problem it solves is structural: every enterprise that uses AI personalisation today must surrender user data to external AI platforms (OpenAI, Google, Anthropic). BlackVault™ eliminates this trade-off entirely.

Hyper-Personalisation	62%+ improvement in AI response quality through user-controlled profiles — demonstrated across 31 empirical comparative tests

1.2 The Technology Is Already Built

1,250+ pages of production-ready enterprise code have been independently validated by Claude Opus 4 (Anthropic) and assessed as “Exceptional – Enterprise Grade.” This is not a concept or a prototype. The Founder is now seeking a European Sovereign AI Partner to acquire the IP, fund the MVP, and lead the deployment of the European AI-Governance Alliance.

1.3 The Regulatory Urgency

The EU AI Act is now in force. From August 2025, enterprises face fines of up to €35M or 7% of global revenues for non-compliant AI deployment. Every enterprise in Europe is under immediate, escalating pressure to deploy AI governance infrastructure. No European-owned, zero-transmission solution currently exists at scale. BlackVault™ is positioned to become that solution — but only if the right ecosystem moves first.

2. Valle Constitucional — The Ecosystem

Constitutional Memory is not a solo operation. The project is architected as a positioned institutional ecosystem — “Valle Constitucional” — anchored in Málaga and designed to position the city as the European home of sovereign AI governance, in direct contrast to Silicon Valley’s surveillance capitalism model.

Where Freepik generates infinite synthetic worlds from Málaga, BlackVault™ protects the real one. The city has already proven it can build global technology from first principles.

The ecosystem has five institutional co-founders, each playing a distinct and complementary role:

Together these five institutions create something that capital alone cannot replicate: an established, credible, multi-institutional ecosystem positioned at the intersection of industry, academia, government, and EU policy.

3. The European AI-Governance Alliance

3.1 The SWIFT Model for AI Governance

SWIFT does not move money — it moves the messages that make money move securely. BlackVault™ does not generate AI responses — it manages the memory layer that makes AI responses trustworthy, personalised, and sovereign. Like SWIFT, it is infrastructure that every enterprise needs but no single enterprise should own.

The European AI-Governance Alliance is a consortium of 10–14 European enterprises that collectively own and govern BlackVault™ through a two-entity structure:

Entity	Role
Alliance (Non-profit)	Governance body owned by 10–14 founding corporate members via Guardian Council. Holds the mission. Cannot be acquired, sold, or merged.
Operations Ltd (For-profit)	Deploys and commercialises BlackVault™. Owned 100% by the Alliance. Generates revenue. Distributes net profits to founding members pro-rata.

3.2 The Sovereign Partner — What Has Already Happened

One major European infrastructure company — the Anchor Founding Member — is in the process of acquiring the BlackVault™ IP via a 6-month Option Agreement. This company is funding the MVP, directing the pilot, and leading Alliance recruitment. It is not a startup seeking investors: it is an established European infrastructure leader taking a strategic governance position.

The technology is being built by a major European enterprise partner. The Alliance is forming around proven, validated infrastructure — not a concept paper.

3.3 What Founding Membership Offers

Each of the 10–14 founding member companies receives:

4. What We Ask of Ecosystem Partners

The ecosystem partners do not invest in Constitutional Memory S.A. directly and are not founding members of the Alliance. Their role is different — and in many ways more foundational. They provide the institutional legitimacy, the introductions, and the physical and policy infrastructure without which no amount of capital can build what this project requires.

4.1 Málaga TechPark

The TechPark is the critical gateway to the corporate founding member community. The specific asks are:

- **MOU / Co-founder Agreement:** Formalise the Valle Constitucional co-founding relationship, enabling public announcement once the Sovereign Partner confirms.
- **Member Introductions:** Facilitate warm introductions to TechPark member companies identified as Alliance founding member candidates, beginning with Telefónica, Indra, IBM Europe, Accenture, and Vodafone.
- **Physical Presence:** Provide space within the TechPark ecosystem for Constitutional Memory and Alliance meetings, pilot demonstrations, and media events.
- **Málaga Positioning:** Co-present the “Valle Constitucional” narrative at TechPark events and in regional communications, positioning Málaga as the home of European sovereign AI infrastructure.

4.2 Universidad de Málaga (UMA)

- **Academic Validation Partnership:** Formal research collaboration on AI governance standards, providing academic credibility and publication pathway for validation claims.
- **AI Governance Research:** Co-author research papers on zero-transmission AI architecture and EU AI Act compliance frameworks; provide peer-reviewed validation to reinforce the “Exceptional – Enterprise Grade” assessment.
- **Talent Pipeline:** Connect Constitutional Memory and the Alliance to relevant graduates and researchers in AI, cybersecurity, and data governance.
- **European Institutional Bridges:** Facilitate introductions to EU-funded research consortia, Horizon Europe programmes, and European university partnerships.

4.3 Junta de Andalucía

- **Regional Government Endorsement:** Public alignment of Constitutional Memory / BlackVault™ with the Andalusian digital strategy and AI competitiveness agenda.
