Volunteer Guidelines

Like most Catholic schools across the nation, our school requires each family to complete volunteer service hours. The volunteer hours requirements program establishes a foundation as a way to involve our families in the day-to-day operations of the school, as well as to save the school money where we can.

All volunteers help with the following:

- Ensure continued success of all our fundraising events
- Guarantees both cost savings and fundraising income for OLSS School
- Provides more activities for our children
- Promotes personal growth
- Brings our student families together
- Strengthens our OLSS community

Families can fulfill their obligation by volunteering at the school and at events that generate funds for the school. This provides cost savings to the school, allows teachers to focus on core academic programs and provides critical support to the mission of our school.

What are the Volunteer Service Hour Requirements?

- All families need to complete a minimum of 40 volunteer service hours (20 hours for part-time Pre-Kindergarten families).
- Participation in four fundraising activities per year is highly encouraged. Volunteer hours accumulate from July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020.
- All hours must be recorded by the volunteer into the logbook located at the school office within 20 days of completion.
- Due to the critical need of support, the volunteer hour requirements are considered part of tuition. Any family who does not fulfill its obligation of required service hours by the deadline will be charged a \$25 fee for each hour not worked.

VIRTUS Program

The Archdiocese of Washington has implemented a Child Protection Policy for the safety of the children in schools and parish ministries. Anyone who wishes to volunteer at the school must first complete all steps of the Archdiocese of Washington's Virtus Child Protection Program. Please visit the OLSS School website for more information and for the necessary forms.

The required steps are:

- 1. Create a VIRTUS account online at http://www.virtus.org
- 2. Register for and attend a Child Protection Workshop (info available from Virtus website)
- 3. Sign and submit the Acknowledgement Form from the workshop booklet to the School Office
- 4. Complete a Volunteer Application Form and submit to the School Office
- 5. Make an appointment with the School Office to have an electronic background check run.
- 6. Complete Live Scan Fingerprinting (NEW REQUIREMENT- must be completed by January 2020)

Once all steps are completed and the background check is cleared, the person may begin volunteering. VIRTUS events will be noted at volunteer sign-up opportunities. If you have any questions pertaining to VIRTUS, please contact Colleen Muldoon in the school office at (410) 326-3171.

What volunteer opportunities are there?

There are yearlong opportunities to complete volunteer hours during days, evenings and weekends. Everyone is welcomed to serve as a volunteer; we can find something for all who wish to serve.

- *Event Chairperson* To make these events happen, a lot of time goes into planning them. Each event requires a chairperson, so please consider putting your planning skills to good use and be rewarded with volunteer requirement hours.
- *Event Preparation Support* Not comfortable leading an event? That is ok; we are always looking for help with event committee members to make these events a success.
- *Event Execution* The day of the event we need helping hands for set up, decorations, clean up, meal prep, and various assistance required with general tasks.
- *Baked Good Donations* Multiple events throughout the year are in need of baked goods to sell and we rely on donations to make them a success
- Hot Lunch Program- Help prepare, set-up & clean up from 9:00am-1:00pm
- Gift Card Sales- Sell cards after Masses in the OLSS Parish Church lobby
