The vineyards are 1,000 feet or more above sea level, where sun-filled days and cool nights, tempered by coastal fogs, combine to consistently produce premium quality grapes. Yorkville vineyards has been certified organic since 1986, so synthetic pesticides, herbicides and chemical fertilizers are not used



Paul Hobbs wines are fermented with native yeasts, aged in French oak, and bottled unrefined and unfiltered, allowing them to produce wines that express their vineyard origins with finesse, complexity and authenticity.

This velvety wine offers a dark cherry hue and aromas of black cherry and bright strawberry. Rich, dark fruits dominate the palate, with accents of red fruit and complex undertones of white pepper and nutmeg.



Ernest Bloom project has crafted a Pinot Noir that displays grace and elegance with a velvety texture and aromas and flavors of earth and spice and the perfect balance of acidity and fruit. So what we have is the perfect example of how great fruit from a cared-for vineyard and the talented hands and knowledge of an esteemed winemaker can create a beautiful and solid wine that is both delicious and versatile.

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Richard the Lion-Heart is unique in that it has all six of the Noble Red grapes originating in Bordeaux. Cabernet Sauvignon 50%, Merlot 25%, Petit Verdot 15%, Malbec 4%, Carmenere 3%, and Cabernet Franc 3%. A dusty garnet color. Fruity, minty with flavors of cherry fruit leather, cola, praline, chocolate mint with a silky, tangy, medium body and a smooth medium-long cranberry.



Mazzocco is nestled in the rolling hills of Sonoma County perched in a saddle between Dry Creek and Alexander Valleys. Mazzocco is renowned for single-vineyard designates. These wines are remarkably individual in nature. A characteristic shared by the award-winning Chardonnay, Merlot, and Cabernet Sauvignon.

Hints of black currant, Bing cherry with chocolate truffle, blackberry, raspberry and leather. This fruit-driven Dry Creek Cabernet is packed with fleshy tannins finishing with hints of French vanilla, cardamom, and vanilla.

The origin or meaning of our name "Enkidu" comes from one of the oldest stories ever recorded: The Epic of Gilgamesh. Written in Sumerian cuneiform nearly 4500 years ago, the story details the life of King Gilgamesh and his best friend Enkidu.

Aromas of currant fruit with garrigue, black spice and a touch of coffee mocha give way to notes of currant and blackberry liqueur on the palate, with a hint of plum skin.
