EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

1. The building is air conditioned and heated. Trial grounds will not be available the night before the trial.
2. No dogs will be allowed into the trial grounds except those properly entered.
3. Dogs eligible to enter are those stated in Chapter 3, 4 and 5 of the AKC Obedience Regulations.
4. WWCDTC assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers or their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to an exhibitor's child. Exhibitors must exercise control of their children at all times while within the trial grounds.
5. Dogs need be present only for scheduled time of judging and may be removed immediately after judging unless required for further judging. Dogs will be judged in catalog order, to the extent that it is practical without holding up judging in another ring. Judges are not required to wait for dogs and it is the responsibility of each exhibitor to have his/her dog ready at ringside without waiting to be called.
6. All trophies must be claimed at the trial. Unclaimed trophies will become the property of WWCDTC upon the completion of the Trial. Where there is a double entry of the same dog only the highest score will be eligible for special awards. Class awards will be given out at the conclusion of the judging of the class; all other awards will be given out after all judging has been completed.
7. As you are aware, securing suitable show facilities is not easy. Help keep our show site clean by picking up after your dog.
8. No private exercise pens are permitted in building. Use designated exercise areas only.

Entries will not be accepted if received without signatures, fees and back of entry form with agreement. An official American Kennel Club entry form must be used. Telephone and telegraph entries cannot be accepted. No entry will be accepted which is made subject to conditions.

Bitches who come in season after the closing date will have the entry fee less \$5.00 refunded upon written certification by a licensed veterinarian to the effect that the bitch in question is in season on the day of the trial. NOTIFICATION MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE TRIAL SECRETARY ONE HALF HOUR BEFORE TRIAL STARTS.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judges, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the Trial giving Club, it is impossible to open or complete the Trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

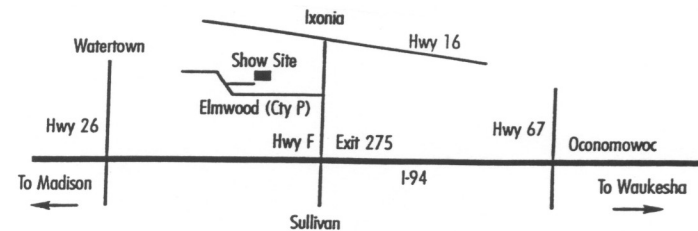
PLEASE BRING YOUR OWN.

- Crating will be available in the building with 6 foot distances. Be courteous to leave when your class is finished and remove your crate so there is ample room for the next scheduled exhibitors.
- Cones will be used for figure 8 posts.
- Jump heights will be in order small to tall.
- We will be following AKC Obedience/Rally guidelines and suggestions for best practices for the well-being of the dog sport participants dated May 12, 2020 and any subsequent updates.
- Please bring your own chair. There will be marks on the floor for you to place your chair ensuring 6 ft between chairs. Bring your chair in and set up without your dog.

DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE

From the East or West: I-94 exit 275 (Sullivan/Ixonia) Cty F. Go north on Cty F to Cty P (approximately 4.5 miles) or Elmwood Avenue. Turn west (left) approximately 1/2 mile to Cedar Drive. Right on Cedar Drive to building at end of road on left.

From the North or South: Hwy 16 west or east to Ixonia. This is approximately 5 miles west of Oconomowoc or 8 miles east of Watertown. Turn left on Cty P (Elmwood Avenue). Just past the railroad tracks. Turn right on Cty P approximately 1/2 mile to Cedar Drive. Right on Cedar Drive to building at end of road on left.

- If you are feeling sick, have a fever, cough or are sneezing before leaving for the trial, please stay home. - There will be entrance and exit doors marked.
- No spectators will be allowed in the building.
- Check-in will be as you arrive at the building at a common location. You will receive a check-in time with instructions after entries close.
- Masks will be required at all times in the building when you are not able to maintain social distancing, when checking in, and when approaching the stewards table.
- Masks are required at the judge's discretion for exhibiting your dog in the ring.
- Should the trial be cancelled due to COVID regulations, entry fees will be returned to the exhibitor.
- Ribbons will be self-serve at ringside after the awards for the class,
- There will be an entry gate and an exit gate for the ring. There will be entry and exit doors for the building.
- Surfaces will be disinfected between dogs and as necessary.
- There will be hand sanitizer and wipes throughout the building.

- Classes will be scheduled throughout the day to help keep the numbers in the building to a minimum. Times will be determined once the entries close
