The classes run for 14 weeks and meet once a week for 60 minutes. The classes are subject of cancellation due to low enrolment.


### HOW TO REGISTER

#### **Description:**

This class is designed for children with little or no background in Spanish. The Very Hungry Caterpillar, from the popular children's book of the same name, will help kids learn how to introduce themselves and greet others, speak about their favorite foods, colors, days of the week, tell how they feel, name objects from the surrounding nature, count to 10, describe things using adjectives like big, small, skinny, fat, and tell long parts of the story in Spanish.

The class focuses mostly on conversation. However, kids will be exposed to some written words and all kids in the class will also be provided with short and fun written exercises.

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The foreign language after-school clubs are taught by Tennessee Language Center ([www.tfli.org](http://www.tfli.org)). With small group sizes, children will receive plenty of individual attention from their instructor Señora Lorena Mondragon. Students will learn to speak and understand Spanish through storytelling and reading, in real life contexts through the use of games, songs, role-playing, arts, food, video, etc. The teacher employs the Communicative Method, Total Physical Response, Story Telling and Drama, which promote the use of the "Target Language" from the very beginning levels in order to gently immerse students in the language in a natural and practical way. The goal of TLC is to provide the students with the necessary skills to actually use and communicate in the language as soon as possible.
