So in some ways, I have a little knowledge of what structural damage looks like.

However, the damage to this building looked bad, but somehow I knew the structural part of the building was not damaged. Damage to the structural foundation is one of the most serious things that can happen to any building.

This is what I sense the Lord is saying to you today:
