Below are our updated policies and procedures for our facility surrounding COVID-19 to ensure the safety of your family, other families and our staff.

Starting June 7th, staff, customers and athletes will not be required to wear masks in our facilities. As always, if you prefer to continue masking you are welcome. The CDC is still recommending that unvaccinated persons wear masks indoors.

Employee Guidelines	 Staff will follow illness policy including symptom documentation and sick protocol. Staff will be diligently trained on procedures and prepared to enforce any and all protocols.
Entering Building	 Athletes should try to arrive in practice attire. Drop/off pick up only is highly recommended. Parents are asked to not enter unless necessary. No more than 1 adult per family will be allowed to enter the building. Spectators are required to follow current CDC guidelines as pertains to masking. Staff/Athletes/Parents MUST document symptoms upon arrival. Anyone appearing ill or presenting with any symptoms will be sent home. Everyone will be asked to sanitize hands upon entering the building. Entrance for Recreational Athletes and Camp North Crest will be made using the South facing door 3 (Caseworks/office side). Athletes should not show up more than 10 minutes prior to practice/class time.
Traffic Flow	 Lobby will have limited seating. Social Distancing dots will be placed for viewing. Occupancy will be limited and continually monitored.
During class	 Dance studio floors have been taped off to ensure social distancing during class. Restrooms will be monitored and disinfected frequently. Drinking fountains will only be allowed for refilling bottles with no-touch sensor, crash bar use will be prohibited. Lost and found items will not be saved, they will be donated daily. Recommended products that are effective against Covid-19 will be clearly identified, accessible and used between all recreational groups throughout the day according to established protocols.
Dismissal	Entrance for Recreational Athletes and Camp North Crest will be made using the South facing door 3 (Caseworks/office side).
