Gerald J. Auten, 88, of Cass City, died Sunday, November 17, 2024 in Courtney Manor Nursing Home, Bad Axe. He married Donna Jean Bader on August 6, 1955 in the Evangelical United Brethren Church in Cass City. She died September 25, 2018. Gerald worked as a mechanic at the Ford Garage and later as a machinist at General Cable for thirty-eight years until retiring in 1998. As a side project he owned a machine shop, Auten Machine and Tool. Gerald's favorite pastime was refurbishing farm equipment. He also enjoyed hobby farming and raising cattle. Gerald was an active member of Cass City United Methodist Church where he served on the administrative board, the building committee, and as a trustee.
