A MESSAGE FROM WALK #159 LAY DIRECTOR

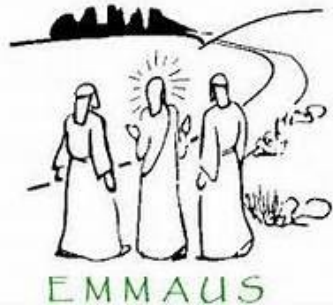
Dear Emmaus Friends,
