**Parents are asked to drop the children off close to the start time of 9am. If you are going to be late, please notify the instructor. Also, please be on time for participant pick-up. There will be no supervision after the program ends at 1:00PM.**

**Unruly behavior is unacceptable and grounds for removal from the program.**

**Students must demonstrate a basic ability to swim and pass the swim test administered by the instructor. Life jackets are not permitted to be worn during the swim test.**

**All students must supply their own life jacket. Any student without a jacket will not be allowed to participate in the program. Life jackets are required to be worn at all times when students are in the boats and on the docks.**

**Shoes/sandals must be worn at all times. Water compatible, tie footwear, Velcro fastened sandals or aqua socks are acceptable footwear. No bare feet are permitted at anytime on the waterfront or in the classroom.**

**Please notify the instructor if the student will be leaving early. At no time shall a student leave the premise without notifying the instructor (this could cause potential alarm should a child come up missing).**
