

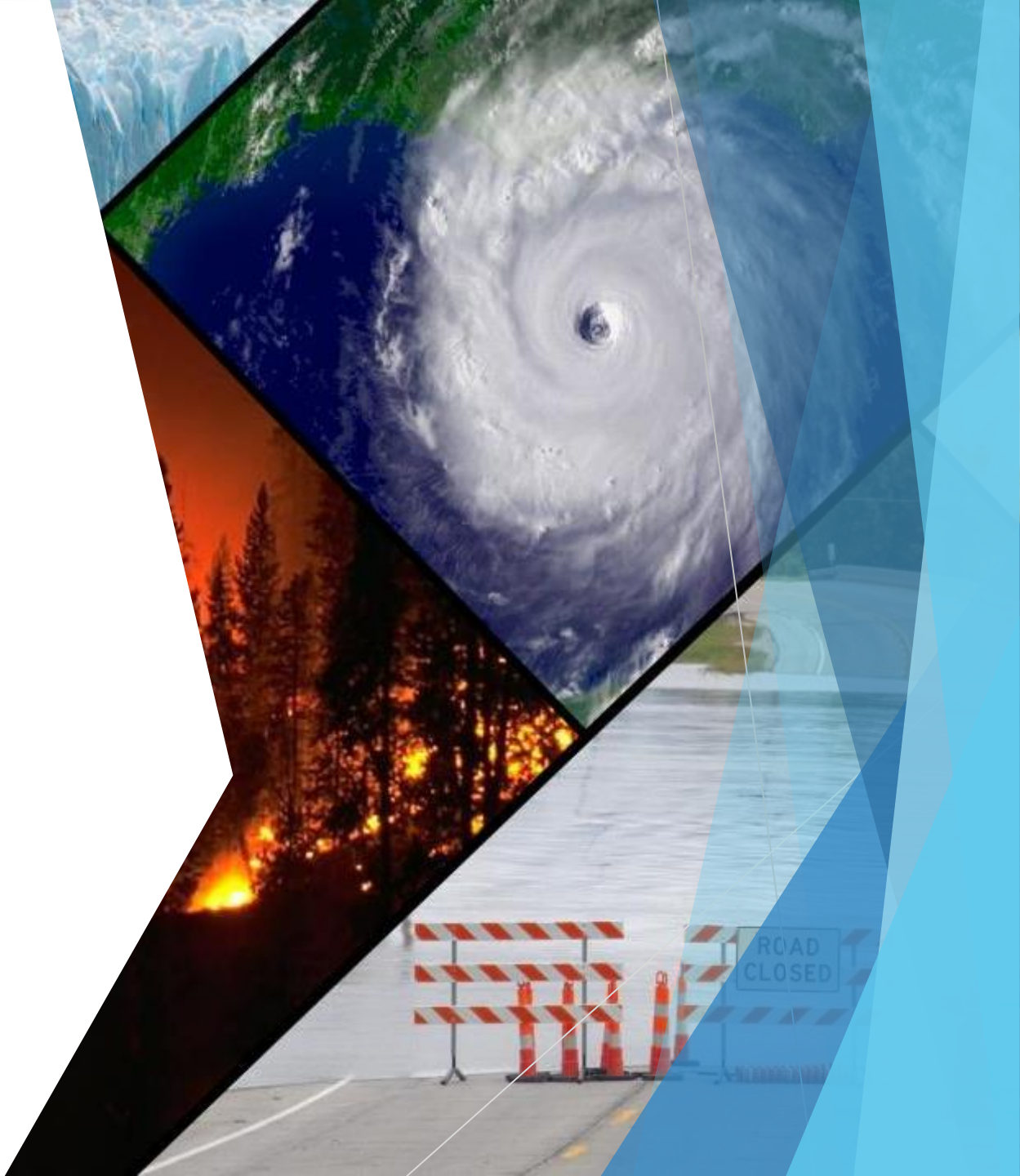

# Prompt & Purpose

- Powerful storm on July 8<sup>th</sup>, 2019
  - 5” of rain in one hour
- Changing climate causes extremes
- Help Fairfax County residents



# Program Summary & Process

- 50% of approved receipts, up to a maximum of \$5,000
- Submit application AFTER purchase/installation
- Must apply for/receive applicable permits/inspections from Fairfax County

# The Numbers...so far

- 24 applications
  - 1 repeat applicant
  - 1 applicant withdrawn
  - 1 applicant denied
  
- \$45,111.43 total out the door
  - \$2,225.57 average reimbursement
  - \$1,725 median reimbursement
  
- Total Inquiries: 37
  - Not every inquiry turned into an application
  - 16 did not apply (yet?)
  - And not everyone who applied inquired beforehand
