Thompson dba THOMPSON ENTERPRISES along with five second feet of water rights in the Colorado River, evidenced by the approved state application number 37470-(05-629). for a total amount of \$25,000.00 for the 193½ Moab Irrigation Shares and \$25,000.00 for the five second feet of water rights amounting to a total of \$50,155.00 was presented and discussed. After discussion D. L. Taylor moved same be approved with the stipulation added to the option that agreement with Moab Irrigation must be finalized to both boards approval and stockholders approval. Sam Taylor seconded. MOTION CARRIED.
