

Further Description of Important Features (Continue on reverse if necessary) Like other homes associated with the Kelley family (eg ERI-1525, ERI-1645, and ERI-1685) the design configuration of this house is unique on the island. Its 2 by 2 bay plan is capped by a channeled metal, pyramidal roof with central brick chimney and ventilation shuttle. The front facade is dominated by a hip-roofed, screened porch. 43. History and Significance Oral tradition indicates that this house was built by Addison Kelley as a home for the house maid or hired hand at his mansion (ERI-1645), some time after 1874. Between c 1890 and 1927 it was probably rented to various families but remained in the hands of the Kelley family.
