Math Supply List

(2024 - 2025)

This year we will be using the **Eureka Math Squared** program. You can learn more about the program on the Math Resources page of our website.

The program consists of 6 modules, each module having a "Learn" book and a "Apply" book. The Learn book will be our daily lessons and small group work while the Apply book will be our homework pages. Since we use these workbooks, there is no need for a separate notebook or binder. You may keep the Apply book at home and tear out the assigned pages as needed. Your Learn book must remain in your locker and brought to math class daily.

Having a **supply of graph paper** is suggested because we often use scrap paper in solving our math problems.

A **supply of pencils** (20 or so) is important. Pen is not allowed in math class. Remember your extra supplies can remain in your locker.

A **supply of dry erase markers** (at least a pack of 6). The color of the ink doesn't matter but we will use these <u>every day in class</u>. The Eureka Math Squared program that we use, requires daily use of whiteboards (supplied by the teacher). Students may also use their own **dry eraser** or use the ones we have in class.

Erasers or pencil cap erasers. Everyone makes mistakes at times, having a supply of erasers helps!

Headphones. Once students are given their school Chromebook, headphones should be kept in the carry case. Remember, Chromebook need to be charged 100% every day. You may carry or chargers in your bags as well.

A water bottle. Staying hydrated is so important and we really don't have time in our classes to go to the water fountain each time we are thirsty. There is a water bottle filling station right outside our room – we fill it up in the morning and after recess. When metal water bottles fall of the desk, everyone in the classroom jumps from the loud noise. Plastic water bottles are best (absolutely no glass bottles).

Backpack: Everything we do in math class will be posted on our website (homeworknook.com) and in Google Classroom so if anything is ever left at school, you can easily download it online. A backpack helps to transport school supplies to and from school.

Drawstring bag: A lightweight, heavy duty drawstring bag will be very helpful as you move class to class. Remember, you will have 3 separate classrooms.

Parents:

This supply list is recommended only. Please know that I will always have the necessary supplies in my classroom for your child (less a water bottle, backpack and drawstring bag). If there are any concerns, please contact me. I will assist you in getting these materials.

Also, throughout the year, it is always **so appreciated** if sanitizing wipes, facial tissues, and hand sanitizer are sent in. I wipe the desks down at the end of everyday and we go through them very quickly.
