



Charles Haddon (C.H.) Spurgeon

"We are not responsible to God for the souls that are saved, but we are responsible for the Gospel that is preached, and for the way in which we preach it."

Born: 1834 Kelvedon, Essex, England

Spurgeon is still known today as the "Prince of Preachers' and prolific writer in many categories; devotionals, hymns, sermons, prayer, commentaries and more. Also known for his preaching style that held many listeners spellbound. Although, a Baptist preacher he enjoyed teaching across denominational lines. In 1867 Spurgeon founded the Stockwell Orphanage for boys and in 1879 for girls. The orphanage and services are still in existence today known as Spurgeon's Child Care or Spurgeon's. He also founded Spurgeon's College in Norwood Hill, Croydon, London which is a Evangelical Christian Theological College.



Iron sharpeneth iron; so a man sharpeneth the countenance of his friend.


Question: What are some of the ways we are able to "sharpen" or help each other through God's love?
