

WILLIAM J. McCARTY 1908 - 1993

William "Bill" McCarty, 84 of Colfax Township, Bad Axe, died Thursday April 8 at Sarasota Memorial Hospital in Sarasota, Fl., following a stroke.

He was born Oct. 10, 1908 in Colfax Twp. at the home of his parents, the late William and Florence (Carr) McCarty. He was united in marriage to Mary E Simons on July 3, 1935, at the home of her parents in Coleman.

Mr. McCarty graduated from Bad Axe High School and from Michigan State University with a degree in agriculture. He returned to Colfax Twp. and continued McCarty's Polled Hereford Breeding, a business his father had started. He retired in 1978, spending his winters in Florida.

He was a member of the Chandler Presbyterian Church, past president of the Michigan Polled Hereford Association and Huron Aviation Club, served on the Board of Directors of the Eldon Elevator, Huron County Fair, Michigan Livestock Exchange, Huron County Farm Bureau and National Livestock Exchange. He member of Bad Axe Lodge #365 F. & A. M. and Sarasota Lions Club and a Charter Life Member of the Eldon Lions Club with 34 years of perfect attendance.
