Dear Parishioners.

As we prepare for our Christmas Mass celebrations, please know that we are doing everything we can to safely welcome as many people as possible into our church to celebrate the birth of our Savior.

Although we continue to implement the sign up procedure for our weekend Masses, it is clear that many come without signing up. Though this has not caused any problems thus far, I worry that it will for Christmas. St. Olaf always welcomes large, overflowing crowds of both parishioners and visitors alike at each one of our Christmas Masses, and even though we don't anticipate the same size crowds as normal, I do feel it necessary to require sign-ups for all Christmas Eve and Christmas Day Masses.

The sign up is posted on our parish website at www.stolafut.org. You must sign up in order to attend. The 5:00pm Christmas Eve service will be our Children's Mass and there will be assigned seating by family, so it is imperative that you specify the number of people that will be attending on the sign-up.

While our goal will be to not turn anyone away, it is my role as pastor to keep our St. Olaf community safe. We look forward to the day that we can safely welcome large crowds back to our church, but until then please help us spread the word about the sign up requirement for all Christmas Masses.
