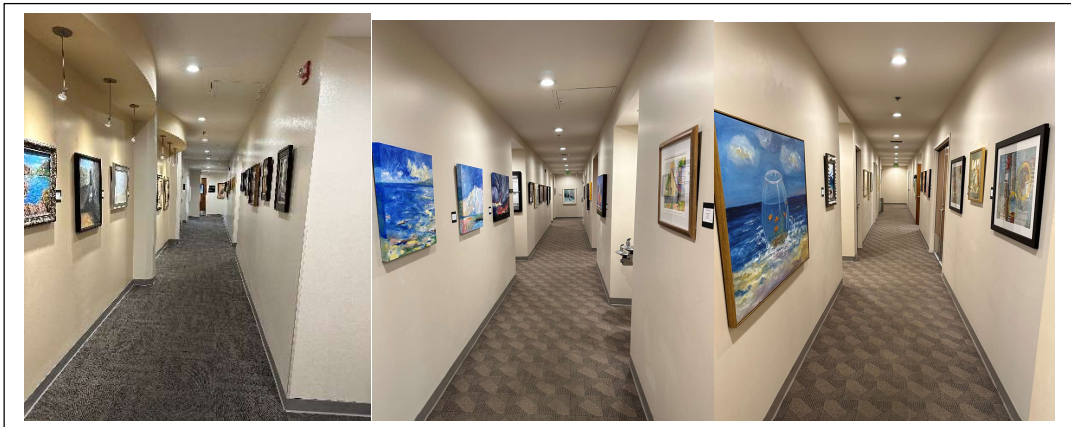

## **Mary Aslin, Pastel Artist**

In 4th grade, Mary completed her first Plein air painting, and that memorable experience seeded a lifelong desire to pursue the arts. She went on to earn a Bachelor of Arts from the University of Washington and then began work as a cartographer. In ensuing years, she studied with renowned artists and took courses at such places as the Gage Academy and the Watts Atelier. She began earning many private and public commissions and worked as Artist in Residence for the Stillwater School District in Stillwater, MN.

Years have passed and now Mary is an Artist Member of the California Art Club, a Signature Member of the Pastel Society of America, the Pastel Society of the West Coast and a Master's Circle Member of the International Association of Pastel Societies. Mary has received considerable recognition for her pastels and has received numerous awards in various exhibitions. She has been recognized in the annual Pastel 100 of ***The Pastel Journal*** and has recently exhibited her work in "***American Women Pastelists in France***" in 2022. She shows her work in the summer at the ***Festival of Arts***, in Laguna Beach.

*waters...* (2022) is a 24-foot-wide-by-16-foot-tall multimedia outdoor sculpture that operates as a combination and continuation of Biggers's *Chimera*, *Shimmer*, and *Codex* series. A hybridized figure, the sculpture combines an archetype of a European reclining male figure with a 19th-Century Baule double-face mask assembled from metal sequins.

**13 Women: Variation II** February 14, 2023 – August 20, 2023 *13 Women* marks the museum's 60th anniversary, paying homage to the thirteen women who founded the Balboa Pavilion Gallery, the earliest iteration of OCMA, which opened in 1962.
