The cost of the session will be £5.00 plus £1.00 skate hire, for both children and adults. Payment must be made direct to Benham on the day. There is a cafe with a viewing area for those parents/carers who don't want to skate.

### Year 2 Swimming

Children in year 2 will have a taster of swimming lessons at the end of this term. This was originally planned to start on 5<sup>th</sup> June, however due to some unexpected closures at the pool this has been revised as follows:
