

## **CGR Volunteer Incentive Program**

Earn CGR “BUCKS” by volunteering for CGR and apply them to costs of attending future CGR events or lessons!

### ***Bucks can be earned the following ways:***

- Volunteering at horse shows in all positions: ring steward, runner, scribe, awards, scoring etc.
- Volunteering to help set-up or pack-up at CGR horse shows. Set-up is the day before and pack-up begins when the show ends.
- Volunteer at CGR clinic events/symposium.
- Help with event preparation work. Examples: stuff event packets, help with event programs, assist with banquet set-up/clean-up, help with annual awards, etc.

### ***CGR Bucks can be applied to the cost of the following:***

- CGR horse show stall costs.
- T-Shirts, Caps, Sweat Shirts etc..
- Lessons -Limit Two Lessons per month
- Youth Camp Fees
- Trail Riding, Obstacles Course Fees
- Can be applied to a Dressage Show Entry, or other horse shows at CGR

Volunteers must be 16 or older, 16-18 year old Volunteers are limited to 18 hours per week during the school year and requires parental consent. You will be working with horses and around horses with limited adult supervision.

## ***Program Administration:***

- Three CGR Bucks will be paid to the volunteer for each hour they volunteer. Example: if you volunteer for eight hours at a show, you will be paid 24 CGR BUCKS. That is \$24 to apply towards an CGR approved program expense. You must work a minimum four-hour shift - CGR bucks will not be paid for less than four hours of volunteering.
  - CGR Bucks are transferable. Your bucks can be given to another CGR volunteer member.
  - After completing volunteer hours, the volunteer is responsible for notifying the volunteer coordinator with the number of volunteer hours worked.
  - Can be applied to a Dressage Show Entry, or other horse shows at CGR
