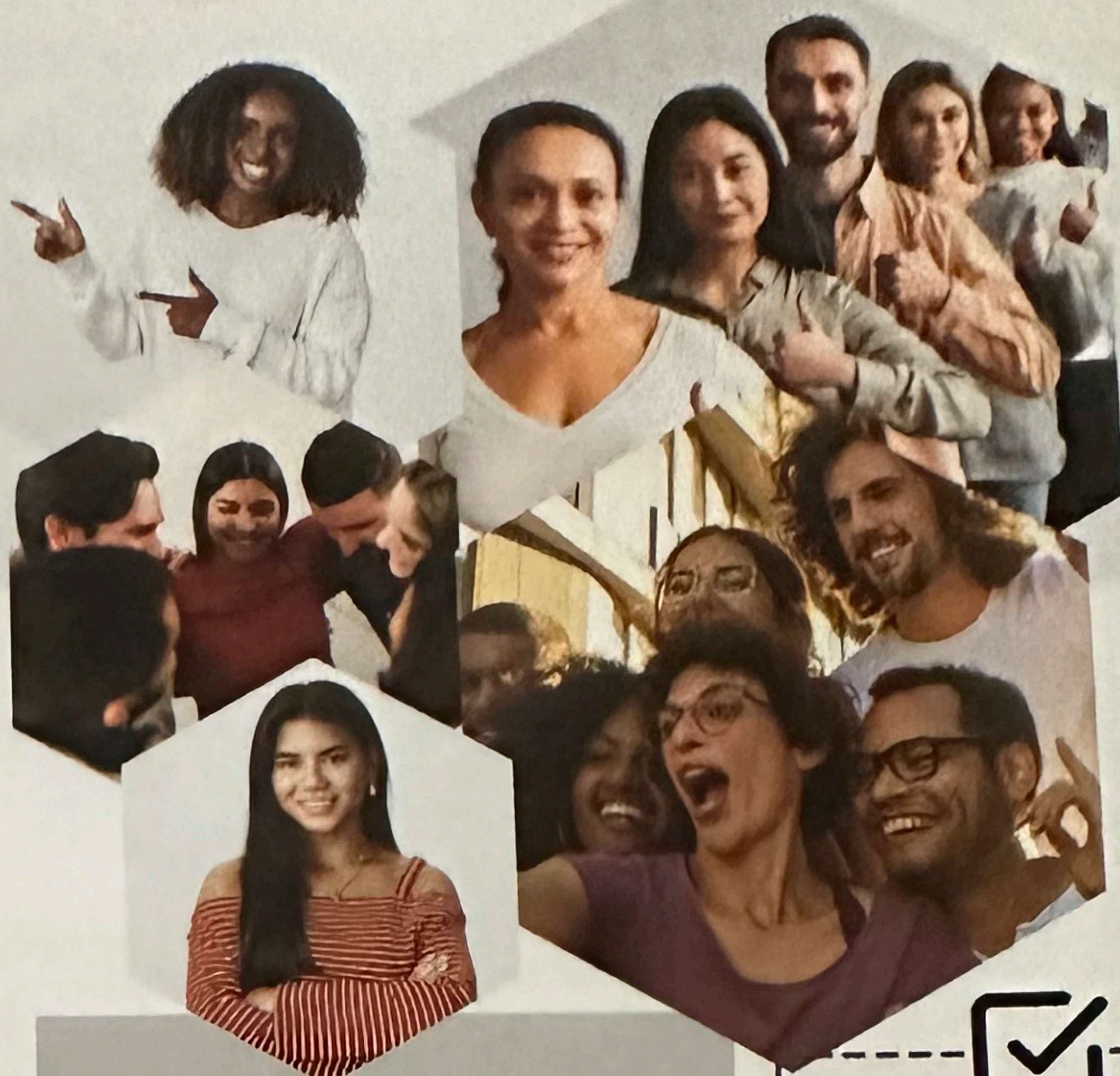


#Say **NO** to Opioids

Pain Medications.



Opiate Pain Medications
are usually
prescribed by Physicians to
relieve severe pain.
Typically, these drugs are
prescribed after surgical
procedures or injuries
or to treat conditions like
cancer.

Common
Opiate Pain
Medications
include

Morphine
(brand name Kadian, Avinza)
Oxycodone
(brand name OxyContin, Percocet)
Hydrocodone
(brand name: Vicodin)
Oxymorphone
(brand name: Opana)
Fentanyl
Codeine

Opiate Pain Medications
can be dangerous if not
used properly and can
lead to addiction and
overdose with fatal
consequences.

It is important to
take Opiate Pain
Medications only
as prescribed by a
healthcare
professional.

Never share Opiate
Pain Medications
with others or take
them if they are
offered to you.

Proper disposal of
unused Opiate Pain
Medications is important
in order to prevent
misuse and abuse of
these medications.

If you or someone you
know is struggling
with opioid addiction,
seek professional help
immediately.

Combining opioids with
other substances such as
alcohol and other
medicines like sleeping
pills or cough medication
increases your chances
of having a deadly end.

Every day, 41
people
in the United
States
die due to
prescription
opioid overdoses.

Doctors may
prescribe
medications that
contain
opioids such as
hydrocodone,
oxycodone, and
morphine to treat
moderate to severe
pain; however, they
can carry serious risks
and side effects such
as drowsiness, mental
fog, nausea, and
constipation.

Medications that
contain
Opioids are highly
addictive and can
lead to dangerous
dependency if they
are ingested more
often than prescribed,
as they alter the
function of the brain
and nervous system.

It is impossible to
predict how your
brain will respond
to opioids before
taking them.
