DESCRIPTION: The Del Rey was Howatt's top bow. A Del Rey model is a rare find indeed. Great looking and performing recurve. Brazilian Rosewood riser with contrasting laminates. The massive riser absorbs shock and makes for a smooth shot. Comfortable grip. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Double-sided overlay tips. Beveled arrow shelf. Overlays and tips are in great condition. A few professionally filled sight screw holes (they were filled with metal and painted over (see pics)). No chips, dings or cracks. No crazing or stress cracks; A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decals are in very good shape. There was a piece routed out of the sight window for some type of arrow rest. This was filled in with putty and colored (See pic on last page). There are sight/quiver bushings on the side of the riser, and the bow has been tapped for a plunger. I don't know if these were added later or done at the factory (Howatt was a friend of the original owner and may have added them as a custom feature. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age.

Comes with a fairly new string.
