

Deuteronomy 13:3 you must not listen to the words of that prophet or dreamer. **The Lord your God is testing you** to find out whether you love him with all your heart and with all your soul (testing you!!!) (pulling at heart strings!)

Psalms 1:6 For the Lord knoweth the way of the righteous: but the way of the ungodly shall perish.

Psalms 46:10 Be still, and know that I am God

Proverbs 8:10-11 Receive my instruction, and not silver; and knowledge rather than choice gold. **For wisdom is better than rubies;** and all the things that may be desired are not to be compared to it

Proverbs 10:30 The righteous shall never be removed: but the wicked shall not inhabit the earth

Proverbs 13:9 "The lamp of the wicked will be put out, but the light of the righteous will shine brightly" (OSAS explain this)

Proverbs 19:14 a prudent wife is from the Lord

Proverbs 21:17 He that loveth pleasure shall be a poor man

Proverbs 24:3 Through wisdom a house is built

Proverbs 26:11 Like a dog that returns to its vomit, a fool does the same foolish things again and again

Ecclesiastes 1:18 For in much wisdom is much grief: and he that increaseth knowledge increaseth sorrow

Isaiah 5:20 Woe unto them that call evil good, and good evil; that put darkness for light, and light for darkness

Isaiah 5:21 Woe unto them that are wise in their own eyes

Isaiah 55:8 For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways

Jeremiah 7:23 Obey my voice, and I will be your God, and ye shall be my people

Jeremiah 17:5 Cursed is the man who trusts in man... but blessed is the man who trusts in the Lord

Ezekiel 36:26 A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you

Ezekiel 47:23 And it shall be that in whatever tribe the stranger dwells, there you shall give him his inheritance," says the Lord God (we are to live in any land w/inheritance!!!)

Daniel 10:5 Then I lifted up mine eyes, and looked, and behold a certain man clothed in linen, whose loins were girded with fine gold of Uphaz (Daniel saw Jesus by the great river on the 24th day)

Daniel 10:7 And I Daniel alone saw the vision: for the men that were with me saw not the vision; but a great quaking fell upon them, so that they fled to hide themselves

Daniel 11:22 And with the arms of a flood shall they be overflown from before him, and shall be broken; yea, also the prince of the covenant

Daniel 12:6 And one said to the man clothed in linen, which was upon the waters of the river, How long shall it be to the end of these wonders? (Jesus was upon the waters of the river)

And I heard the man clothed in linen, which was upon the waters of the river, when he held up his right hand and his left hand unto heaven, and swore by him that liveth for ever that it shall be for a time, times, and an half; (mid-trib rapture?) (this is not the same rapture vision as Daniel 10)

Daniel 12:10 In the end times, the wicked shall do wickedly: and none of the wicked shall understand; but the wise shall understand

Hosea 2:23 and I will say to them which were not my people, Thou art my people; and they shall say, Thou art my God (zionists explain this)

Hosea 4:1-2 Hear the word of the LORD, ye children of Israel: for the LORD hath a controversy with the inhabitants of the land, because there is no truth, nor mercy, nor knowledge of God in the land (zionists explain this)

Hosea 4:6 My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge: because thou hast rejected knowledge, I will also reject thee, that thou shalt be no priest to me: seeing thou hast forgotten the law of thy God, I will also forget thy children ("Fear the Lord")

Hosea 6:2 After two days will he revive us: in the third day he will raise us up, and we shall live in his sight (3 days of "Feast of Trumpets")

Hosea 6:3 Then shall we know, if we follow on to know the Lord: his going forth is prepared as the morning; and he shall come unto us as the rain, as the latter and former rain unto the earth

Joel 2:1 Blow ye the trumpet in Zion, and sound an alarm in my holy mountain: let all the inhabitants of the land tremble: for the day of the Lord cometh, for it is nigh at hand

Joel 2:28 And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh; and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions (zionists explain this)

Haggai 2:18-20 Consider now from this day and upward, from the four and twentieth day of the ninth month, from this day will I bless you

Zechariah 14:16 And it shall come to pass, that every one that is left of all the nations which came against Jerusalem shall even go up from year to year to worship the King, the Lord of hosts, and to keep the feast of tabernacles

Zechariah 2:11 And many nations shall join themselves to the Lord in that day, and shall be My people. And I will dwell in your midst

NEW TESTAMENT

Matthew 5:8 Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God (Heart!)

Matthew 6:5 And when thou prayest, thou shalt not be as the hypocrites are: for they love to pray standing in the synagogues and in the corners of the streets, that they may be seen of men

Matthew 6:32-33 "your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things. But seek first His kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well"

Matthew 7:13-14 The Narrow and Wide Gates "Enter through the narrow gate. For wide is the gate and broad is the road that leads to destruction, and many enter through it. But small is the gate and narrow the road that leads to life, and only a few find it

Matthew 10:28 And fear not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul: but rather fear him which is able to destroy both soul and body

Matthew 10:32 Whosoever therefore shall confess me before men, him will I confess also before my Father which is in heaven

Matthew 10:39 For whoever would save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake will find it

Matthew 15:8 These people draw near to me with their mouth, and honor me with their lips, but their heart is far from me (Heart)

Matthew 18:3-4 Jesus says, "Truly I tell you, unless you change and become like children, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven. Therefore, whoever humbles himself like this child is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven (OSAS explain this)

Matthew 19:14 Jesus said, "Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these." (there are kids in heaven; therefore we do repopulate)

Matthew 19:24 Again I tell you, it is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for someone who is rich to enter the kingdom of God"

Matthew 19:30 But many who are first will be last, and many who are last will be first

Matthew 21:43 "Therefore I tell you that the kingdom of God will be taken away from you and given to a people who will produce its fruit" (zionists explain this)

Matthew 22:14 For many are called, but few are chosen (OSAS explain this)

Matthew 23:11-12 The greatest among you will be your servant. For those who exalt themselves will be humbled, and those who humble themselves will be exalted.

Matthew 23:13 But woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you shut up the kingdom of heaven against men; for you neither go in yourselves, nor do you allow those who are entering to go in (Jesus 7 Woes to scribes and Pharisees; this is just one)

Matthew 23:25 Jesus condemns the scribes and Pharisees, calling them hypocrites for outwardly appearing clean while being inwardly filled with greed and self-indulgence, like a cup cleaned on the outside but filthy inside

Matthew 24:30-31 And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.

And he shall send his angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other

Matthew 26:74-75 (Peter denies Jesus 3 times and the last time cursed) Then he began to curse and swear, saying, "I do not know the Man!" (never deny Jesus!)

Immediately a rooster crowed. And Peter remembered the word of Jesus who had said to him, "Before the rooster crows, you will deny Me three times"

Matthew 28:2 "And behold, there was a great earthquake; for an angel of the Lord descended from heaven, and came and rolled back the stone from the door and sat upon it." (when Jesus rose)

Mark 1:8 "I baptize you with water, but he (Jesus) will baptize you with the Holy Spirit"

Mark 5:9 And Jesus asked him, "What is your name?" He replied, "My name is Legion, for we are many" (Demons)

Mark 7:18-19“Don’t you see that nothing that enters a person from the outside can defile them? For it doesn’t go into their heart but into their stomach, and then out of the body.” (In saying this, Jesus declared all foods clean)

Mark 8:36 For what shall it profit a man, if he shall gain the whole world, but lose his own soul?

Mark 13:11 And when they bring you to trial and deliver you over, do not be anxious beforehand what you are to say, but say whatever is given you in that hour, for it is not you who speak, but the Holy Spirit

Mark 13:13 Jesus states, "But he who endures to the end will be saved"

Mark 13:14 But when ye shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing where it ought not, (let him that readeth understand,) then let them that be in Judaea flee to the mountains (Daniel 9:27 deniers explain this)

Mark 13:20 And except that the Lord had shortened those days, no flesh should be saved: but for the elect's sake, whom he hath chosen, he hath shortened the days

Mark 14:42 Rise up, let us go; lo, he that betrayeth me is at hand (**Judas** betrayed Jesus) (they spit on Jesus)

Mark 15:17 They dressed Him in a purple robe, twisted together a crown of thorns, and set it on His head (Jesus's crucifixion)

Mark 15:31 the chief priests and scribes mock Jesus, saying, "He saved others; himself he cannot save (Jesus came to die for us)

Mark 15:34 And at the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice, 'Eloi, Eloi, lema sabachthani?' which means, 'My God, My God, why have you forsaken me?'

Luke 1:31 And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus

Luke 2:11 For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord

Luke 2:48-50 and his mother said unto him, Son, why hast thou thus dealt with us? behold, thy father and I have sought thee sorrowing.

And he said unto them, How is it that ye sought me? wist ye not that I must be about my Father's business? And they understood not the saying which he spake unto them (zionists stop! Jesus is our Lord from Heaven above)

Luke 6:20 Blessed are you who are poor, for yours is the kingdom of God

Luke 6:40 The student is not above the teacher (there has to be a hierarchy)

Luke 6:44 Jesus states, "Each tree is recognized by its own fruit (revealing their true character)

Luke 6:46 "Why do you call me, 'Lord, Lord,' and do not do what I say? (OSAS explain this)

Luke 6:48 he is like a man building a house, who dug deep and laid the foundation on the rock

Luke 9:62 And Jesus said unto him, No man, having put his hand to the plough, and looking back, is fit for the kingdom of God (don't look back; unwavering commitment)

Luke 10:23-24 And turning to the disciples, he said privately, Blessed are the eyes which see the things that ye see: for I say unto you, that many prophets and kings desired to see the things which ye see, and saw them not; and to hear the things which ye hear, and heard them not

Luke 10:27 Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy strength, and with all thy mind; and thy neighbour as thyself

Luke 12:2-3 everything that is hidden will be shown, and everything that is secret will be made known

Luke 12:8 Also I say unto you, Whosoever shall confess me before men, him shall the Son of man also confess before the angels of God (NEVER deny Jesus like Peter did)

Luke 12:32 Do not be afraid, little flock, for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom

Luke 16:15 You are those who justify yourselves before men, but God knows your hearts. For what is highly esteemed among men is an abomination in the sight of God (your Heart)

Luke 17:21 Jesus states, "Nor will they say, 'Look, here it is!' or 'There it is!' For behold, the kingdom of God is within you" (zionists explain this) (it comes from the Heart)

Luke 18:16 But Jesus called the children to him and said, "Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of God belongs to such as these (we do populate! We have children in Heaven)

Luke 21:16-18 You will be betrayed even by parents and brothers, relatives and friends; and they will put some of you to death. And you will be hated by all for My name's sake. But not a hair of your head shall be lost

Luke 21:25 And there shall be signs in the sun, and in the moon, and in the stars; and upon the earth distress of nations, with perplexity; the sea and the waves roaring

Luke 22:34 And he said, I tell thee, Peter, the cock shall not crow this day, before that thou shalt thrice deny that thou knowest me

Luke 22:48 Jesus looked at him with sorrow and said, "A kiss, Judas? Are you really going to betray the Son of Man with a kiss?"

Luke 23:34 Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do

John 1:11-12 He came unto his own, and his own received him not. But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God

John 1:51 "Truly, truly, I say to you, you will see heaven opened, and the angels of God ascending and descending on the Son of Man"

John 3:36 Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life

John 5:43 I have come in my Father's name, and you do not receive me. If another comes in his own name, you will receive him

John 8:23 Jesus said, "You are from below; I am from above. You are of this world; I am not of this world" (zionists explain this)

John 8:44 Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, for he is a liar, and the father of it (zionists explain this) (see Rev 2:9, Rev 3:9)

John 10:27-28 My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me: and I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, and no one shall snatch them out of my hand

John 12:25 He that loveth his life shall lose it; and he that hateth his life in this world shall keep it unto life eternal

John 13:21 "Verily, verily, I say unto you, that one of you shall betray me"

John 14:1-3 In My Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also

John 14:6 Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me

John 14:17 Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you

John 15:5 I am the vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye can do nothing

John 15:15 Henceforth I call you not servants; for the servant knoweth not what his lord doeth: but I have called you friends; for all things that I have heard of my Father I have made known unto you

John 15:16 Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go and bring forth fruit, and that your fruit should remain (OSAS explain this)

John 15:18 If the world hate you, ye know that it hated me before it hated you

John 15:19 If ye were of the world, the world would love his own: but because ye are not of the world, but I have chosen you out of the world, therefore the world hateth you

John 15:27 And ye also shall bear witness, because ye have been with me from the beginning

John 18:36 Jesus answered, "My kingdom is not of this world. If my kingdom were of this world, my servants would have been fighting, that I might not be delivered over to the Jews. But my kingdom is not from the world (zionists explain this)

John 19:11 Jesus answered, "You would have no power over me if it were not given to you from above. Therefore the one who handed me over to you is guilty of a greater sin

John 19:28 After this, Jesus knowing that all things were now accomplished, that the scripture might be fulfilled, saith, I thirst

John 20:29 Jesus saith unto him, Thomas, because thou hast seen me, thou hast believed: blessed are they that have not seen, and yet have believed

Acts 1:8 But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you

Acts 2:17 And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams

Acts 2:38 repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit

Acts 14:22continue in the faith, and that we must through much tribulation enter into the kingdom of God

Acts 15:8-11 God knows people's hearts, and he confirmed that he accepts Gentiles by giving them the Holy Spirit, just as he did to us. He made no distinction between us and them (Zionists explain this)(Heart)

Romans 1:21when they knew God, they glorified him not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened (Heart)

Romans 1:22 Professing themselves to be wise, they became fools

Romans 1:24 Wherefore God also gave them up to uncleanness through the lusts of their own hearts, to dishonour their own bodies between themselves

Romans 1:25 They exchanged the truth about God for a lie, and worshiped and served created things rather than the Creator (zionists explain this)

Romans 1:26 Because of this, God gave them over to shameful lusts. Even their women exchanged natural sexual relations for unnatural ones

Romans 1:27 In the same way the men also abandoned natural relations with women and were inflamed with lust for one another. Men committed shameful acts with other men

Romans 1:28 God gave them over to a reprobate mind, so that they do what ought not to be done

Romans 3:10 "There is no one righteous, not even one"

Romans 2:29 But he is a Jew, which is one inwardly; and circumcision is that of the heart, in the spirit, and not in the letter; whose praise is not of men, but of God (zionists explain this)(Heart)

Romans 3:29 Or is God the God of Jews only? Is he not the God of Gentiles too? Yes, of Gentiles too (zionists explain this)

Romans 4:16 ...which is of the faith of Abraham; who is the father of us all

Romans 8:31 If God is for us, who can be against us?

Romans 8:4 That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit

Romans 9:8 They which are the children of the flesh, these are not the children of God (it comes from the Heart)

Romans 9:24 Even us, whom he hath called, not of the Jews only, but also of the Gentiles (zionists explain this)

Romans 9:27 concerning Israel, Though the number of the children of Israel be as the sand of the sea, a remnant shall be saved (all 12 Tribes Jews and Gentiles)

Romans 10:4 For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to every one that believeth

Romans 10:12 For there is no difference between the Jew and the Greek: for the same Lord over all is rich unto all that call upon him (zionists explain this)

Romans 10:21 But to Israel he saith, All day long I have stretched forth my hands unto a disobedient and gainsaying people

Romans 11:18 do not boast against the branches. But if you do boast, remember that you do not support the root, but the root supports you (quit thinking your so great, it's the root that makes you great)

Romans 11:8 God hath given them the spirit of slumber, eyes that they should not see, and ears that they should not hear; unto this day (through pineal gland? same strong dillusiion, hive minds, put it in their heart? God gave them over, etc)

Romans 12:8 he that giveth, let him do it with simplicity; he that ruleth, with diligence; he that sheweth mercy, with cheerfulness

Romans 12:20-21 Therefore if thine enemy hunger, feed him; if he thirst, give him drink: for in so doing thou shalt heap coals of fire on his head. Be not overcome of evil, but overcome evil with good

Romans 14:11 For it is written, every knee shall bow to me, and every tongue shall confess to God

1 Corinthians 2:5 that your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God

1 Corinthians 2:9 Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him

1 Corinthians 3:16 Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in you

1 Corinthians 3:18 If any man in this world profess to be wise, let him become a fool

1 Corinthians 4:7And if you did receive it, why do you boast as though you did not (humble yourself)

1 Corinthians 4:14 I write not these things to shame you, but as my beloved sons I warn you

1 Corinthians 6:9 Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God. Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind (OSAS explain this)

1 Corinthians 6:19-20 Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own; you were bought at a price

1 Corinthians 11:29-31 For he that eateth and drinketh unworthily, eateth and drinketh damnation to himself, not discerning the Lord's body. For this cause many are weak and sickly among you, and many sleep

1 Corinthians 12:13 For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body, whether we be Jews or Gentiles (zionists explain this)

1 Corinthians 13:11-12 When I was a child, I spoke as a child, I understood as a child, I thought as a child; but when I became a man, I put away childish things

1 Corinthians 15:51-52 Behold, I tell you a mystery: We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed

1 Corinthians 15:53 For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality (your new immortal body)

2 Corinthians 4:18 While we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen: for the things which are seen are temporal; but the things which are not seen are eternal

2 Corinthians 4:4 In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them

2 Corinthians 5:7 For we walk by faith & not by sight

2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new

2 Corinthians 6:14 Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness?

2 Corinthians 6:16 And what agreement hath the temple of God with idols? for ye are the temple of the living God; as God hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people.

2 Corinthians 6:17 Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you.

2 Corinthians 6:18 And will be a Father unto you, and ye shall be my sons and daughters, saith the Lord Almighty

2 Corinthians 11:6 But though I be rude in speech, yet not in knowledge; but we have been thoroughly made manifest among you in all things

2 Corinthians 12:9 God's strength is made perfect in weakness

Galatians 1:10 If I were still trying to please man, I would not be a servant of Christ

Galatians 3:28 There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus (zionists explain this)

Galatians 4:26 But Jerusalem which is above is free, which is the mother of us all

Galatians 3:29 If you belong to Christ, then you are Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise (Abraham father of ALL Jews)

Galatians 5:14 For the whole law is fulfilled in one word, in this: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself'

Galatians 5:16 This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not gratify the lust of the flesh

Galatians 5:19-22 Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness, Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies,

Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God (OSAS explain this)

Galatians 5:22-23 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law

Ephesians 2:8-9 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast

Ephesians 3:13 Do not lose heart at my tribulations for you, which is your glory (Heart)

Ephesians 4:17 and testify in the Lord, that ye henceforth walk not as other Gentiles walk, in the vanity of their mind

Ephesians 4:24 And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness

Ephesians 4:31 Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger, and clamour, and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice

Ephesians 4:32 And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you

Ephesians 5:5 For this ye know, that no whoremonger, nor unclean person, nor covetous man, who is an idolater, hath any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and of God (OSAS explain this)

Ephesians 5:6 Let no one deceive you with empty words, for because of these things the wrath of God comes on those who are disobedient

Ephesians 5:8 For ye were sometimes darkness, but now are ye light in the Lord: walk as children of light

Ephesians 5:18 And be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; but be filled with the Spirit

Ephesians 5:23 For the husband is the head of the wife, even as Christ is the head of the church

Ephesians 6:11-12 Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.

*For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places

Philippians 2:10-11every knee should bow and every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord

Philippians 3:21 who, by the power that enables him to bring everything under his control, will transform our lowly bodies so that they will be like his glorious body

Colossians 2:3 In him are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge

Colossians 2:5 For though I be absent in the flesh, yet am I with you in the spirit

Colossians 3:2 Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth

Colossians 3:10 And have put on the new man, which is renewed in knowledge after the image of him that created him

Colossians 3:18 Wives, submit yourselves unto your own husbands, as it is fit in the Lord

Colossians 3:24 Knowing that of the Lord ye shall receive the reward of the inheritance: for ye serve the Lord Christ

1 Thessalonians 2:12 That ye would walk worthy of God, who hath called you unto his kingdom and glory (God chose you)

1 Thessalonians 2:13ye received it not as the word of men, but as it is in truth, the word of God

1 Thessalonians 3:12 and may the Lord make you increase and abound in love for one another and for all, as we do for you

1 Thessalonians 4:16-17 For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first:Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord

1 Thessalonians 5:2-4 For yourselves know perfectly that the day of the Lord so cometh as a thief in the night.For when they shall say, Peace and safety; then sudden destruction cometh upon them, as travail upon a woman with child; and they shall not escape. But ye, brethren, are not in darkness, that that day should overtake you as a thief

2 Thessalonians 2:2-3 That ye be not soon shaken in mind, or be troubled, neither by spirit, nor by word, nor by letter as from us, as that the day of Christ is at hand.Let no man deceive you by any means: for that day shall not come, except there come a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition (to understand 2 Thessalonians you must understand there's 4 Beasts) (4 Beasts pdf <https://shorturl.at/eeikir>)

2 Thessalonians 2:7 For the mystery of iniquity doth already work: only he who now letteth will let, until he be taken out of the way (restrainer removed)

2 Thessalonians 2:8-9 And then shall that Wicked be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy with the brightness of his coming. Even him, whose coming is after the working of Satan with all power and signs and lying wonders, (4 Beasts pdf <https://shorturl.at/eeikir>)

2 Thessalonians 2:10-12 And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved. And for this cause God shall send them strong delusion, that they should believe a lie (pineal gland?)

That they all might be damned who believed not the truth, but had pleasure in unrighteousness

2 Thessalonians 2:13-14 But we are bound to give thanks always to God for you, brethren beloved of the Lord, because God hath from the beginning chosen you to salvation through sanctification of the Spirit and belief of the truth: (God chose you)

Whereunto he called you by our gospel, to the obtaining of the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ

1 Timothy 1:9 Knowing this, that the law is not made for a righteous man, but for the lawless and disobedient, for the ungodly and for sinners, for unholy and profane, for murderers

1 Timothy 6:11 But thou, O man of God, flee these things; and follow after righteousness, godliness, faith, love, patience, meekness

2 Timothy 3:2-4 In the last days men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy.

Without natural affection, trucebreakers, false accusers, incontinent, fierce, despisers of those that are good. Traitors, heady, highminded, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God

2 Timothy 3:5 Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof

2 Timothy 3:7 Ever learning, and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth

Titus 2:2-6 That the aged men be sober, grave, temperate, sound in faith, in charity, in patience. Young men likewise exhort to be sober minded. The aged women likewise, that they be in behaviour as becometh holiness, not false accusers, not given to much wine, teachers of good things;

That they may teach the young women to be sober, to love their husbands, to love their children. To be discreet, chaste, keepers at home, good, obedient to their own husbands, that the word of God be not blasphemed

Hebrews 13:2 Do not neglect to show hospitality to strangers, for thereby some have entertained angels unawares

James 1:12 Blessed is the man who endures temptation; for when he has been approved, he will receive the crown of life which the Lord has promised to those who love Him

James 1:22 But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves

James 2:24 You see then how that by works a man is justified, and not by faith alone. (OSAS explain this)

1 Peter 1:4 an inheritance incorruptible and undefiled and that fadeth not away, reserved in heaven for you

1 Peter 1:8 Though you have not seen him, you love him; and though you do not see him now, you believe in him and you rejoice with joy inexpressible and full of glory

1 Peter 1:15-16 But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation; Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy

2 Peter 1:21 prophecy came not to man but Holy men moved by the Holy Spirit

2 Peter 3:13 But according to His promise, we look for new heavens and a new earth, in which righteousness dwells (heaven's)

1 John 2:12 I write unto you, little children, because your sins are forgiven you for his name's sake

1 John 2:15 Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him

1 John 2:19 They went out from us, but they were not of us; for if they had been of us, they would have continued with us

1 John 2:20 But ye have an unction from the Holy One, and ye know all things

1 John 2:28 And now, dear children, continue in him, so that when he appears we may be confident

1 John 3:2 Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is

1 John 3:16 By this we know love, that he laid down his life for us, and we ought to lay down our lives for the brothers

1 John 4:17 In this the love of God is perfected with us, that we may have confidence on the day of judgment, because as he is, so are we in this world
