Location

Hold convention in area of state of the Deanery that is hosting

Hold conventions at a parish / mass at that parish

Hold at location where we can bring in outside catering

Hold separate mass for DCCW attendees only – outside normal mass at church/cathedral – or rotate location of mass to different parishes near convention location

New Ideas

Hold multiple events throughout the year to build community, set calendar and really advertise and market the events
