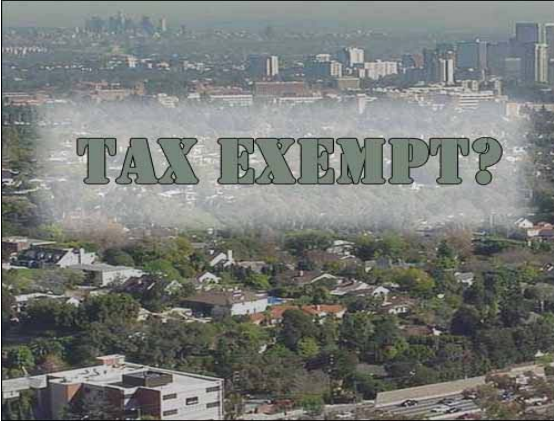


ADMINISTRATION OF PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTIONS
