

OBLIGATION OF CLIENT

Definition: Service Period is one (1) week.

- Client will be responsible for payment weekly and due upon receipt of invoice.
- Agency reserves the right to re-evaluate Client and reassess the fee based on client need.
- Client or any person responsible for Client agrees to pay ONE AND A HALF times the agreed upon hourly rate when the Caregiver works on the following holidays:
 - ❖ After 6:00pm New Year's Eve
 - ❖ New Year's Day
 - ❖ After 6:00pm Christmas Eve
 - ❖ Christmas Day
 - ❖ Easter Sunday
 - ❖ Memorial Day
 - ❖ Labor Day
 - ❖ Independence Day
 - ❖ Thanksgiving Day

Expense Reimbursement

Client will reimburse Caregiver's expenses incurred on behalf of a client within seven (7) days of receipt of proof of expenses. Expenses may include, but are not limited to: groceries, parking, bus fare transportation utilizing Caregivers car at current reimbursement rate per mile.

Live In

Client shall provide adequate, proper, and reasonable accommodations for Caregiver's sleeping conditions, food and nutritional support. Client will ensure Caregiver obtains eight (8) hours of sleep in a twenty-four (24) hour period.

Terms of Agreement

Term is indefinite and shall be renewed by timely receipt for next service period payment.

Except as otherwise provided herein, this Agreement may be terminated by either party with five (5) days prior written notice.

In the event of Client's hospitalization, Agency will suspend Caregiver services until return from the hospital. Credit will be given in the next billing cycle for the days Agency services were not rendered. Agreement will not be terminated by temporary interruption of suspension of service.

Services may be terminated without five (5) days notice if one of the following occurs:

- Client requests transfer or discharge
- Client requires services or care that the Agency cannot provide
- Client needs full-time care by a licensed healthcare professional; or needs to be institutionalized.
- In the event of a disaster when the Client's health and safety is at risk in accordance with provisions of 97.256 relating to Emergency Preparedness and Implementation.
- For the protection of the staff or Client after a documented reasonable effort to notify the Client, the Client's family and physician, if applicable, the appropriate state or local authorities of the Agency's concern for staff or Client's safety, in accordance with the Agency's policy.
- Client no longer lives in the geographical area served by the Agency
- If client fails to pay for services.
