Saturday July 20th Sheep check in/weigh in 8:00am - 9:30am. Showmanship at 10:00, classes will follow

<u>Saturday July 20th:</u> Goat weigh in 8:00-10:00 Goat showmanship will begin 15-20 minutes after conclusion of sheep show, Classes will follow showmanship

Saturday July 20th: Beef Check In/weigh in 1:00-3:00pm, Beef Showmanship begins at 4pm

Market Swine, Sheep, and Goat Entries: \$21.00 for market classes, \$11.00 for showmanship, Paid early entries must be postmarked by July 12, 2024, Entries day of show: Class \$31.00, Showmanship \$16.00, Pee Wee Showmanship \$1.00, Cash Only

\*No intact males may be shown - ewes, gilts, does all eligible\*

\*Please no ringworm or wool fungus\* \*no horns on market goats, must be disbudded\*

\*No Painting, Adhesive, Powdering, or Artificial coloring allowed\*

Beef Entries: \$ 35.00 for class and \$15.00 for showmanship Paid early entries must be postmarked by July 12, 2024, Entries day of show: Class \$50.00, Showmanship \$25.00, Pee Wee Showmanship \$1.00, Cash Only

- ⇒ Commercial heifers and steers will be split Brahma and Non-Brahman and show by weight, classes pending entries
- ⇒ Commercial Heifers and steers will be exhibitor classified and will be verified at scales
- ⇒ No sheens or hair additives allowed, Soap and water only
- ⇒ Steers can be shown with or without hair
- ⇒ Breeding classes will be Brahman or
- Non-Brahman influence
- ⇒ Miniatures will be separated by Brahman and Non-Brahman
- ⇒ Registered Heifers are not eligible as commercial heifers
- ⇒ Registration papers must be present at check in, papers pending are accepted
- ⇒ All bulls should have nose rings
- ⇒ Show management and Judges decisions are final
- ⇒ Following LSU rules unless otherwise stated

Swine Showmanship 6pm oldest to youngest

- 15 & up Senior div
- 12-14 Intermediate div
- 9-11 junior division
- Novice under 9 for LJSC Points
- Grand drive
- Reserve Drive
- Peewee non points

Market Hogs: Show by weight, no minimum, no maximum, no intact males

Classes by weight order lightest to heaviest followed by grand drive and the second place from same class will return for reserve selection

Sheep Showmanship: 10am. Oldest to youngest,

- 15 & up Senior div
- 12-14 Intermediate div
- 9-11 junior division
- Novice: under 9 for LJSC Points
- Grand Drive
- Reserve Drive
- Peewee non points

Market sheep: Show by weight, no minimum, no maximum, no intact males

Goat showmanship: 15-20 minutes following conclusion of sheep show

- 15 & up Senior div
- 12-14 Intermediate div
- 9-11 junior division
- Novice under 9 for LJSC Points
- Grand Drive
- Reserve Drive
- Peewee non points

Market goats: Show by weight, no minimum, no maximum, no intact males, must be dehorned

Beef Showmanship: 4pm

- 15 & up Senior div
- 12-14 Intermediate div
- 9-11 junior division
- 9 and under for Points
- Peewee non points

Market Steer: immediately following beef showmanship, Show by weight, no minimum, no maximum, no intact males

Commercial Heifers: show by weight, lightest to heaviest

Beef Breeding: classes will go from youngest to oldest, Heifers followed by bulls, Brahman influence, then non brahman influence

Selection of overall supreme will include both brahma and non brahma influence for bulls and will include commercial heifers for the selection of supreme females.
