WELL # 4: Pump shaft was sheared off, bushings are worn well #4 out, we need to replace at least first 20 ft of bushings, all drop pipe which is corroded and at least the first piece of shaft. Board discussed the following points: Only two repairs in 12 years, should perhaps repair and save as backup. Dale stated that if we repair it looks like approximately \$7000.00, plus it will take two weeks before the pump can be rebuilt and installed. If we go with a new submersible pump it will cost us \$8711.00, perhaps more. Delivery time on new pump, two days. If we go to submersible it will be lower maintenance.

Dan Holyoak suggested the District purchase the submersible pump and get well # 4 operable by the weekend.

Dan's suggestion met with the consensus of those present.
