

Evening 2 – Hanukkah, Chanukah (Monday)

12.23.19 – Rachael Martin

Significance: Remembering the re-dedication of the Temple after it was defiled by the Greeks

Observances: Lighting candles, reciting prayers and scriptures

Length: 8 days (This year, December 22-30, 2019)

Customs: Praying, Eating fried foods; playing with a dreidel (top)

The Torah reading for each day of Hanukkah is taken from **Numbers 6:22-8:4**, which recounts the dedication of the *mishkan* (temporary, moveable place of worship) by the Israelites in the desert. On Shabbat during Hanukkah, we read the regular weekly portion. During the Festival of Lights, the *Haftarah* readings, additional selections from the Prophetic books, are **Zechariah 4:1-7** and **I Kings 7:40-50**.

We light the Lead Candle and then we light the 1st & 2nd candles and say:
(Candles are added from right to left and kindled from left to right.)



**Baruch atah, Adonai Eloheinu, Melech haolam, asher kid'shanu
b'mitzvotav v'tsivanu l'hadlik ner shel Hanukkah.**

English: Blessed are You, Adonai our God, Sovereign of all, who hallows us with mitzvot, commanding us to kindle the Hanukkah lights.
