Auto Burglary Prevention Tips:

- Do not leave ANY personal or valuable items inside the vehicle. Removable stereo systems and GPS navigation devices (dashboard or windshield mounted) should never be left in a vehicle.
- ✓ If you must leave items in a vehicle, place them out of sight.
- Lock all valuables inside the trunk <u>before</u> arriving at your destination.
- Coins should not be placed in sight in the vehicle.
- When you park, look for spots in well-lighted and well-travelled areas.
- ✓ Lock the doors and roll the windows up.
- If you have an alarm system, use it. Alarms can be used as an additional deterrence.
- Even a locked vehicle can be burglarized therefore reduce the likelihood of your vehicle from being targeted by removing all items from plain sight.

Call the police if you see anyone suspicious around vehicles or if you see someone tampering with a vehicle. Immediately report break-ins and thefts to the Oceanside Police Department.
